The Guardian has received from a leading New York fish dealer the statement that they must have received 500 boxes of smelts from Prince Edward Island the week previous, which were all thawed out, soft and in bad condition for market. The thawing out alone would not have been so very harmful, had not the re-handling of the fish at many different points muddled them up and made them present an untidy and distasteful appearance. The following reasonable and valuable suggestions were also given, which will be appreciated by shippers in this Province:—It is not over ten days ago that these very same smelts were selling 10 and 11 cents on this market, and we are safe in saying that they have sold 50 and 75 cents per box and some few at 8 cents per lb. We think it would be a good idea if the shippers of smelts would have their shipments concentrated to one point, say Charlottetown, get a refrigerator car and pack them and send them on consignment to some firm here with an order that that dealer distribute to the various dealers that the shippers desire. It would result in their getting a very much lower freight rate and the main thing their smelts would not be re-handled so often and reach here in good condition. From our own observation, we believe that at least two carloads from the Island reached New York last week, so there is no excuse for the fishermen that they could not load a car by concentrating their shipments to one point.
