PLANT DIVORCE CASE TO BE PROCEEDED WITH. BOSTON, Mass., Oct. 19.—The rumored reconciliation between Thomas G. and Mrs. Plant, which was spread about last June, has received its death blow for on next Monday morning in the Suffolk divorce court the libel filed by Mrs. Plant on January 18, 1911, will be heard among the untested cases. The Plant divorce case has been the subject of much rumor and speculation since it was first filed, nearly two years ago. The first happening of importance, following immediately upon the footsteps of the filing of the divorce papers, was the granting of a special precept of attachment to Mrs. Plant for 1,500,000 by Judge Hitchcock. Thomas G. Plant was the head of Thomas G. Plant Shoe Co. About a year ago he sold out his patents upon which he built up his business to the United Shoe Machinery Company. The Plants were married at Chicago on June 26, 1895, and lived together in Boston until September, 1909. Mrs. Plant bases her libel on alleged infidelities of her husband on Oct. 1, 1909, at Bangor and Calais, Me., at other times at St. George, N. B., New York city, and other places with a woman unknown to her Tyler and Young appeared as counsel for Mrs. Plant and Sherman B. Whipple entered his appearance for Mr. Plant. On March 11 of this year Mr. Whipple withdrew his appearance and the case was placed on the untested list of divorce cases which are to be heard next Monday.
