Maritime Grain Yields  
Can Be Increased

(Experimental Farms News)

Recently there has been considerable discussion about the feed grain requirements of the Maritime provinces. Admittedly, these three provinces are not producing sufficient grain to support their livestock and must import additional supplies. Without arguing the merits or drawbacks of importation, it might be well to consider what can be done to increase production, says R. B. MacLaren, Dominion Experimental Station, Charlottetown, P. E. I.

An increase in the quantity of grain produced may be achieved in three main ways: increased acreage, better choice of varieties and care of seed, and fertilizing the grain crop.

An increase in acreage may be to the advantage of some farmers, particularly if it takes the form of diverting part of the root land to grain crops. This would apply only to farms where the acreage of roots is relatively large. If the increased acreage means breaking extra stubble or sod land its value is questionable. In such cases the farmer must give careful thought to the long time effect on soil fertility, keeping in mind that grain crops, particularly oats, are

heavy feeders and do nothing to improve the soil.

The use of suitable varieties of grain, together with seed cleaning and treatment, offer a way of increasing grain production without reach of all farmers who do not already give attention to these details. Rust-resistant varieties of oats and wheat offer excellent insurance against damage from these diseases. In addition the term "suitable varieties" implies better quality grain and favourable ripening dates. If seeding is necessarily delayed, the use of a late maturing variety may result in crop failure. Seed treatment for one control of smut, root rots and other seed-borne diseases will undoubtedly increase yields. One per cent of smut sounds unimportant, but even as slight an infection as this might reduce the oats crop in Prince Edward Island by as much as 40,000 bushels.

Applications of commercial fertilizer, either broadcast or by means of a combined seed and fertilizer drill, will not only boost yields but will also enable the young grass and clover plants to become well established. Such plants stand a much better chance of winter survival. The quantity and kind of fertilizer to use will depend on such factors as type of soil and state of fertility. The benefit from fertilizer applications will also depend on moisture conditions. Occasionally, dry weather following seeding may keep the chemicals from dissolving and

their effect will be delayed. However, this does not happen often enough to discourage fertilizer applications.
