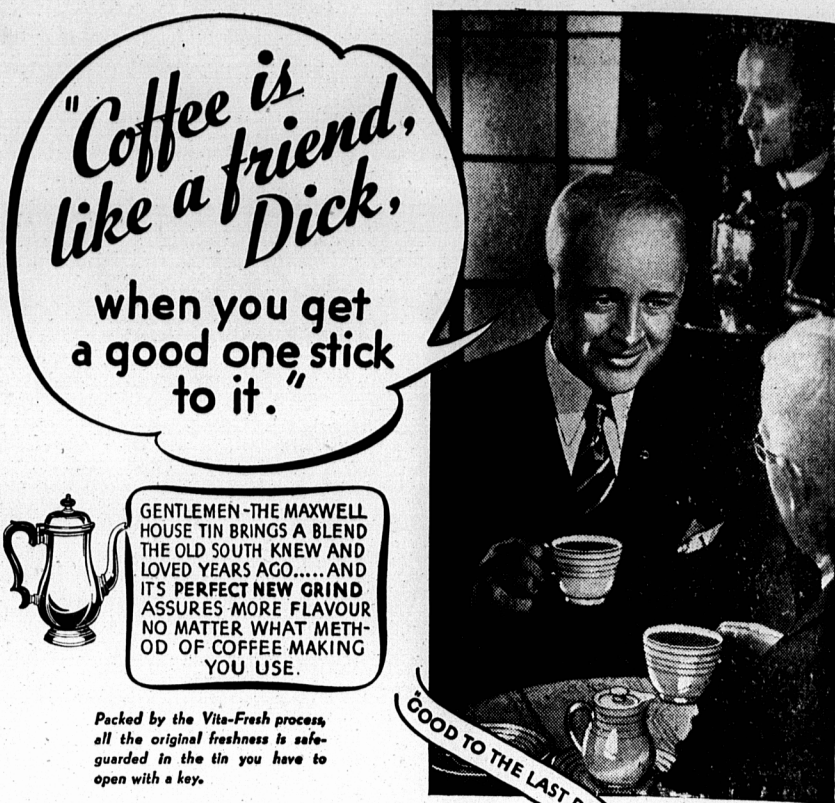

THE COOK'S CORNER

PEARL TAPIOCA CREAM.

This is another old-timer—and one that has lost no charms with the years, when it is carefully made. It should have the effect of delicate pearls of translucent tapioca, not too thickly set in a smooth and flavorful custard.

- 1-4 cup pearl tapioca 2 cups milk 2 egg yolks 1-3 cup sugar Few grains salt 2 egg whites 3 tablespoons fruit sugar

Wash tapioca, cover with cold water and soak overnight. Drain, and add milk; cook over boiling water, stirring occasionally, until clear.

PINEAPPLE TAPIOCA.

In this dish, tapioca has gone a bit modern, for we use it in that quick-cooking form that makes puddings of very great delicacy and allows an almost unlimited breadth and put coats on the stairs for her to trip over.

Two eggs, 2 cups flour, 4 tablespoons sugar, 4 tablespoons melted butter, 1 cup sweet milk, 1 cup raisins, 3 teaspoons baking powder. Steam 1-2 hours in cups.

- 1-2 cups sago 1-3 cups boiling water 1-3 teaspoon salt 5 medium-sized apples 1-3 cup sugar Whole cloves

Place tapioca, sugar and salt in top of double boiler. Stir in pineapple syrup which has been heated to boiling. Cook over hot water, stirring often, until tapioca is clear (about 15 minutes). Add lemon juice and pineapple. Turn into serving glasses. Chill Top with whipped cream. Sprinkle with silvered candied pineapple, or chopped nutsmeats, if desired.

APPLE SAGO.

Sometimes we make a tapioca and apple pudding all in the double boiler; but this method of baking the pudding is one that is dear to

the heart of a lot of cooks—and it turns out a delicious dessert. 1-2 cup sago 1-3-4 cups boiling water 1-3 teaspoon salt 5 medium-sized apples 1-3 cup sugar Whole cloves Wash sago cover with cold water, and let stand one hour. Drain, add boiling water and salt, then cook over hot water until clear, stirring occasionally.

Pare and slice apples, and arrange in greased baking dish. Sprinkle with sugar, and add a few whole cloves. Cover with sago. Bake in moderate oven, 350 degrees F., until apples are tender.
