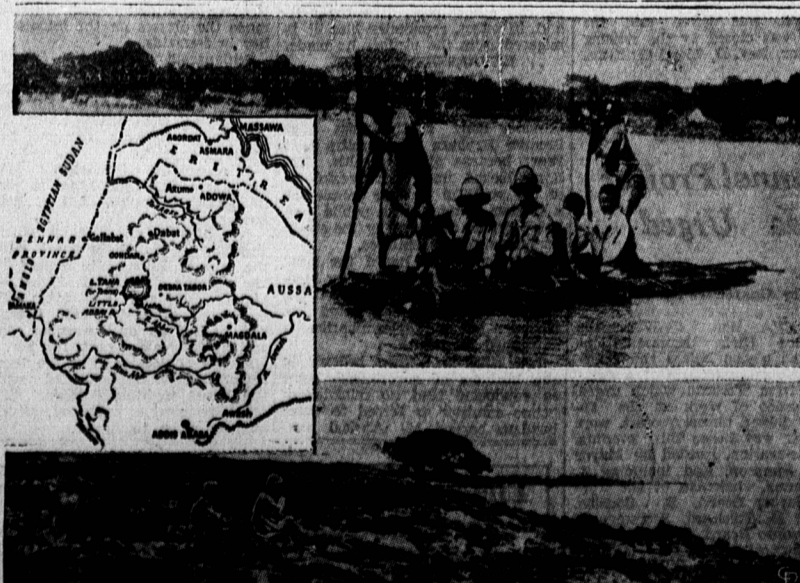

The supplies caused by the poles in these matters are theoretically registered in the House of Parliament. The two Englishmen (seated LEFT) are being ferried across the Blue Nile (also called the Abba Adda River), about two miles below Lake Tana (or Tanna) in Ethiopia. At this point the river is about 180 yards wide and the water rushes by at the rate of 500,000 cubic feet per second. The country controlling Lake Tana could divert the waters of the Blue Nile much to the detriment of the agriculturists in the Egyptian Soudan valley of the Nile, in which the British are

deeply interested. The raft incidentally, is made of a native wood tied together by thongs. After a week or so of use it becomes water-logged and is discarded. BELOW is a view of the lake for which, it is reported, Britain once offered \$5,000,000 to Ethiopia. It was refused.

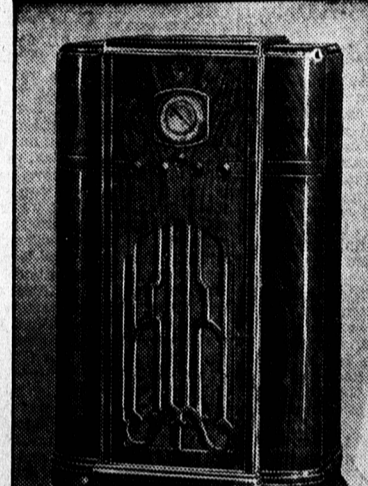
