Bren Report Highlights

(C. P. by Guardian's Special Wire) OTTAWA, Jan. 13 - Here are highlights of the report of Mr. Justice H. H. Davis inquiry into the Bren gun contract.

The report recommends the Government set up a "defence purchasing board" to handle munition orders, accountable to the Prime Minister and the Finance Minister.

It finds no official of defence department guilty of "any act of corruption or anything in the nature of corruption."

No member of the Senate or House of Commons was admitted to any part of the Bren contract or any benefits given or promised arising therefrom.

Responsibility of deciding whether contract properly negotiated and whether or not tenders should be called was placed directly upon Government and Parliament.

No substantial objection was made to provisions of contract but the commission was unable to pass upon its substance in absence of competitive bids.

Because rights of individuals interested in contract might become subject to legal controversy else where the commissioner refused to comment on evidence in respect of its bearing on their conduct, leaving that to the courts and Parliament to act as they see fit.
