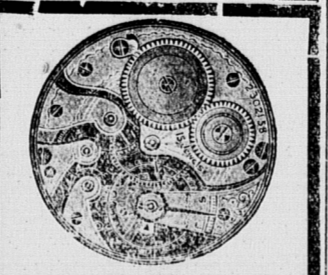

James Lewis, Cardigan, left this City en route to Boston, yesterday morning.

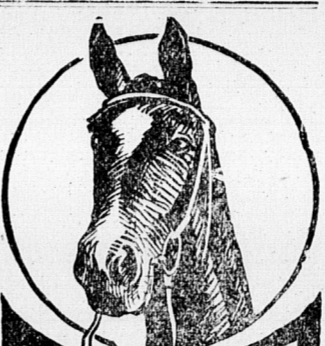
William and Mrs. Carruthers, Carleton, spent their Easter holidays visiting friends in the City.
