MONTREAL, May 17 (CP)—Receipts on Montreal livestock markets today were 62 cattle, 164 calves, 349 hogs and 8 sheep and lambs.

No early cattle sales were made. Calves were unchanged. Good veals made \$7 with medium kinds from \$5 to \$6.50, and common to just fair quality veals in mixed lots from \$5.15 to \$5.50. Drinkers ranged from \$4 to \$4.75.

Sheep were \$4. Hogs were sold on a rail grade basis at \$12 to \$12.35 cold weight.

On Maritime markets rail grade hogs declined 5 cents to \$11.35 but changed at \$6.40 off trucks. Sows were steady at \$7.80 dressed weight and \$5.65 off trucks.

Choice steers were \$6.75, good \$6, medium \$5.25, fair \$4.75 and common \$4. Choice heifers made \$6.25, good \$5.75, medium \$5, fair \$4.25 and common \$3 to \$3.75.

MONTREAL, May 17 (CP)—Potato and egg prices weakened but other offerings held steady on open produce markets here today, the Dominion Department of Agriculture reported.

Creamery butter prints to retailers sold for 21 1-2-2 1/2 cents a pound and solids for 21-21 1/2. Western butter was unquoted. Quebec No. 1 pasteurized fresh in wholesale jobbing lots made 20 5-8-3-4.

Ontario colored cheese brought 10 1/4 cents a pound.

Graded egg shipments in used free cases were sold at 21-21 1/2 cents a dozen for A-large; 19-19 1/2 for A-medium; 18 1-2-19 for B-large; 17 for C.

WINNIPEG, May 17 (CP)—Lack of moisture in western Canada and sections of the United States winter wheat belt prompted commission houses buying in Winnipeg today and held wheat futures prices steady. Closing quotations were unchanged to 1-8 cent higher, with May at 63 7/8, July 65 and October 66 cents.

A small export business in Canadian wheat was reported but no definite figure was available.

Liverpool was influenced by yesterday's decline on North American markets and finished 1-24 down. Chi. scored slight gains while Buenos Aires showed little change.

Can wheat trade included a small demand for the top Northern grades by exporters and mills. Pit trading in coarse grains uncovered fair malter support in barley as well as a little export interest in oats.
