Councillor Macdonald followed in the same strain. The following committees were then, on motion, appointed, the first named councillor being Chairman in each case:—

Finance—Riley, Lane, Johnson. Streets—Macdonald, Campbell, McKenna, Taylor and Riley. Market—Campbell, Taylor, Lane. Fire Committee—Johnson, Lane, Campbell. Light—McKenna, Matthews, McDonald.

Councillor Matthews was appointed First Assistant Chief of the Fire Department. On motion Richard Grant, Henry Lowe and Philip Large were appointed Assessors.

H. M. Davison and L. B. Miller, were appointed Auditors for the ensuing year. J. J. Johnson, K. C., was on motion appointed to the position on the City School Board vacant by the death of the late Thomas Handrahan.
