FROM BELGIUM

The following letter was received by Mrs. Ernest Griffin, Albion, P. E. Island, by her son who is now in the trenches. Belgium, Jan. 19th Dear mother—Have been awaiting a letter from you this long while but may be it got delayed. Have been here for one month and have some experience to go through. We came out of the trenches a couple of days ago. It is awful muddy but we are all in good spirits. We are billeted in a barn and have a big stove so it is nice and comfortable compared with the trenches. Our trenches are only thirty yards apart in some places and at night when things are quiet we can hear them talking quite plain. We have lost very few men compared with the start of the war. We are about four miles from the firing line now and enjoying a holiday. My health has been good but some of the boys find the wet weather too much for them. Hope you all are well as I have been dreaming about you a lot lately. Never hear from Sister Helen now, she evidently has forgotten my address.
