

**MASSACRE BY A GENDARME.**

**ROUMANIA QUESTIONS BRITAIN.**

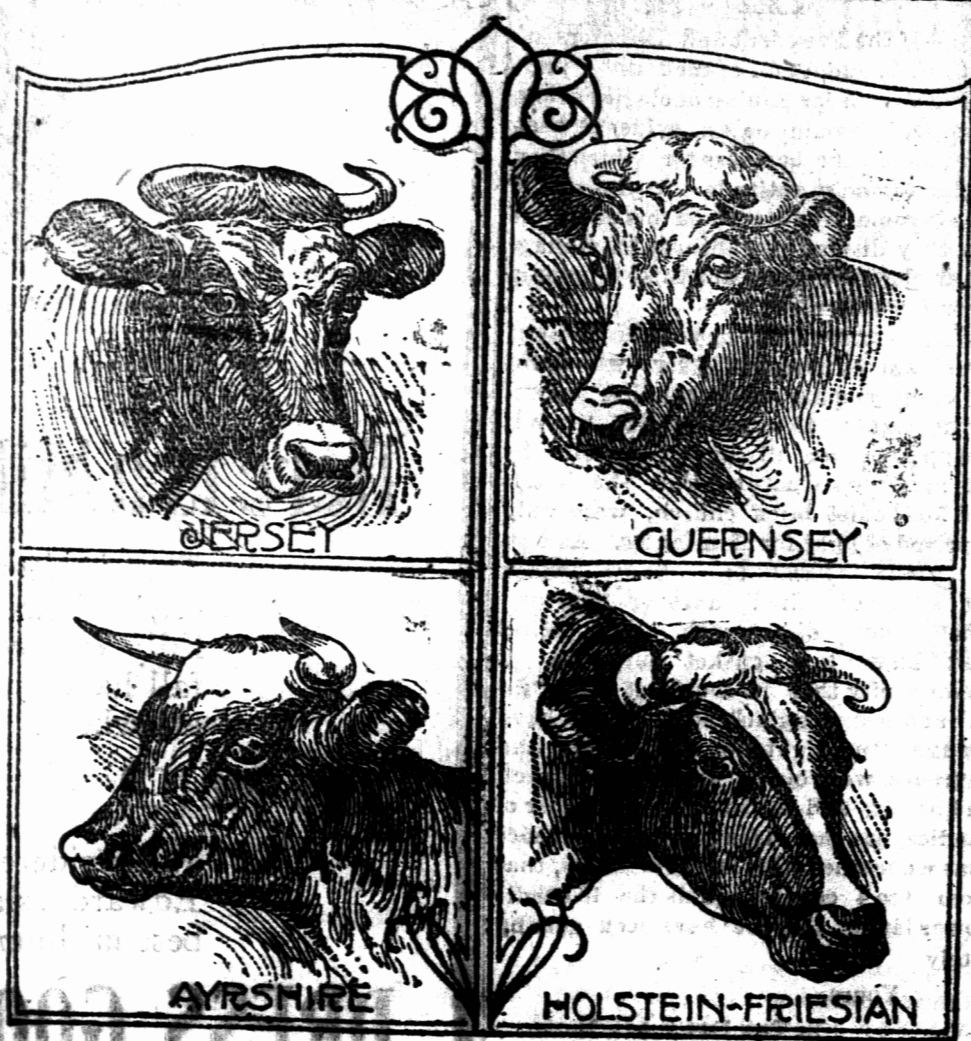
