## SOME STATISTICS ABOUT LONDON

Population of Greater London Exceeds 7,000,000— Enormous Traffic — 2,158 Miles of Streets— Other Interesting Statistics About the Greatest City in The World.

LONDON, Sep. 8.—Everything that can be told in statistics is continued in the fascinating record of Life in London compiled by a statistical officer of the London County Council.

London embraces an area of 75,449 acres; it has a population of more than 7,000,000; Greater London has a population of 7,119,560.

The following is the yearly return of marriages, births and deaths: Marriages, 30,886; rate per 1,000, 17. Births, 129,338; rate per 1,000, 47.9. Deaths, 71,900; rate per 1,000, 16.9.

As regards the passenger traffic in Greater London, the figures are stupendous. For 1904 the following are the figures:

There are in all fifty-seven premises in the administrative county where the public performance of stage plays takes place regularly. The approximate seating accommodation of the theatres is 71,015, and rateable value £139,808.

There are forty-six music-halls and theatres of varieties, with seating accommodations for 53,611 persons, and a rateable value of £281,261. Under the head of concert halls, dancing saloons, etc., there are 318 premises, including places so widely divergent as Earl's Court Exhibition and a mission hall. Altogether the premises licensed in London for public entertainment have seating accommodation for at least 312,260.

There are 7,382 licensed premises, with a rateable value of £2,184,031. London's yearly post-bag is thus described in figures:

The widest street in London is Piccadilly.

11,341 motor-cars were registered in 1904-5.

More than 52,000 articles were left in public carriages by forgetful passengers.

There are 2,158 miles of streets in the county, and they are maintained at a net cost of £2,100,210.

The net annual cost of the London police is £1,833,558. The total cost for England and Wales is £1,321,132.

The council spends £1,638,262 every year in maintaining its parks and open spaces which are 4,945 acres in extent.

The number of public carriages licensed by the Metropolitan Police is 16,370. The drivers and conductors number 31,912.

### EDITOR'S MAIL.

#### SOME OTHER BAD WEEDS

Str.—I noticed the bright blue flowers of the Wild Chicory—Cicorium intybus—along the railway track, behind Holman's. As I went into Summerside recently. They are showing themselves round the back sheds where horses feed in Alberton, and elsewhere also. This is a very common way-side and waste-land weed in Quebec and Ontario, and more than likely we got it in the Quebec hay, winter before last. Whilst it is not as noxious as the thistle, daisy or ragwort, it is no addition to our flora and should not be allowed to spread.

A. D. McDonald, Beach Point, Kings County, sends me a pant by to-day's mail which he says is spreading about his settlement. It is the redoubtable Baughian, or ragwort—Senecio Jacobaea which, alas, has secured a footing all over the Province. Everyone interested in this plant-menace to our animal life (and who is not?) should write "Dr. Rutherford, Live Stock Commissioner, Ottawa," for a copy of his recent report, based on Dr. Pethick's experiments at Cloverdale, N. S. It costs nothing—not even a stamp, and must greatly inform the community.

Writing to me recently Dr. Fletcher, Dominion Botanist, who was not thoroughly convinced of the plant's part in the Pictou Cattle Disease previously, says: "Dr. Rutherford's report on our odorous dried the Baughian, has at any rate stirred up some sleepy people to make enquiries about it, and your work of drawing attention to it may now be helped by our being able to say that it is in some way directly responsible for injury to cattle."

I regret that the desire to cut it down has not seized people earlier in the season. The seeds are now blowing over country. The Agricultural Department will need to beat it itself this season.
