property might be inherited by Countess Lassey.

Pantchenko, confessed his guilt, but set up the defence that he committed the crime while under the hypnotic influence of the count. As the trial progressed he wavered matters of detail and his lawyers were quick to strengthen his original defence by declaring to the court that their client was still under the influence of the count to such an extent that he was little by little retracting the vital points of his confession.

Today the public prosecutor took cognizance of the situation, and after referring to the proximity of the prisoners in the dock, made a motion that the cardinal question of his guilt or innocence be proposed against Pantchenko. He said that the replies of the prisoner had been unsatisfactory throughout his examination. The court granted the motion and the formal question of the indictment was again read. Once more the aged physician replied that he was guilty of Bouturlin's death.

His examination was then continued. Asked whether he had administered poison to his victim, Pantchenko demurred, saying that he would answer that question after the date of the medical experts, who had made the post-mortem, had been presented in court. He explained that he did not sterilize his hypodermic syringe after he had sent some one on the way to the grave, because the sperm
