2 Chron. 34: 1-18.

POINTED SUGGESTIONS

The doctrine of hereditary influence gets a jolt now and again by such histories as those of Manasseh and Josiah. The one goes bad from the example and inheritance of a good father and the other goes well from the example of a bad father and a heritage of woe. But it takes more than a jolt to overturn a doctrine that is so well-established. Remember that Josiah, the mother, must be counted in and that Josiah was only eight years old when he began to reign.

The contrast that Josiah makes with Manasseh is refreshing. And that the worthy balance lies altogether with Josiah is to be credited to the fact that his character was built and his policies were planned upon his tenderness of heart. Because of this he made David his example and squared his conduct with thoughtfulness and manliness and spiritual devotion.

In brief, Josiah sought to do what was right in the eyes of the Lord. And the one who does that will always retain for himself that best of blessings, namely, tenderness of heart, while he will be at the same time the constant receiver from God of courage and strength. "The eyes of the Lord run to and fro throughout the whole earth to show Himself strong in behalf of those whose hearts are perfect towards Him." The tender heart produces the strong life.

And Josiah did not put off the doing of the things that his tenderness of heart suggested. He took up responsibility from the start. What an outrage on mental capacity and spiritual power in childhood is committed by those who discourage the Christian ambitions of the young, saying to them, "Wait till you are

older!" "Thorough" seemed to be the watchword, with which matters were undertaken. Bad things in the nation's life and in the idolatrous worship of the people were cleaned out to the bottom. And that is a New Testament doctrine for the treatment of sin. A heart is no more cleaner than a cistern until it is cleaned-purged out to the bottom.

Then it can be known what has been the extent of the damage and what must be the nature of the repair. Time is not wasted on the building which is earnestly given to making the foundation secure. But so soon as that is secure remember that a foundation is not a house. Build.

There must have been some safeguard nobodies around the Jerusalem temple. That sort gather around great institutions in the course of time somehow. But Josiah's reformation wakes them up until treasures are found and books are unearthed and things are set agoing on a better basis.

Why had that money been collected and nothing done with it? "Money is like manure. It is of no use unless it is spread." It is to find its way under Josiah's programme into the hands of those who ought to have it, namely the hands of faithful work-

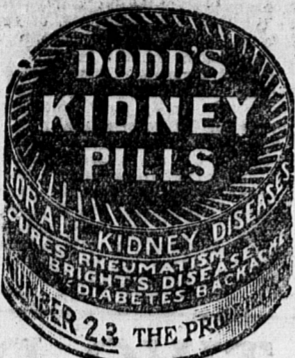

SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH WEST LAND REGULATIONS.

ANY person who is the sole head of a family or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency, on certain conditions, by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader. Duties—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister. In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section alongside his homestead. Price \$2.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside upon the homestead or pre-emption six months in each six years from date of homestead entry including the time required to earn homestead patent and cultivate fifty acres extra. A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead rights and cannot obtain a pre-emption may enter for a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$200 per acre—Duties—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$500.00.

P. E. ISLAND RAILWAY

Commence Monday, June 5th, 1911. Trains will run daily, Sunday excepted as follows:

Table with columns: Trains Outward, Trains Inward, Read Down, Read Up. Lists train numbers and destinations like Ch'town, Mt. Stewart, St. Peter's, Souris, Cardigan, Vernon, Montague, Geo'town, etc.

The construction of an all-rail route to the mainland would mean many improvements in Prince Edward Island. Regular and daily communication is now maintained during the season of open navigation by two steamers under a subsidy from the Dominion Government. Regular navigation is generally closed from the middle of December to the middle of April. During this period ice-breaker steamers running with more or less regularity carry passengers, the mails, and some freight to and from Pictou Nova Scotia. Under unfavorable conditions the mails, on sleds, are pulled over the ice between the two capes named above. "Prince Edward Island now produces annually about \$10,000,000 worth of field and animal products. Owing to the uncertainties of navigation after November the farmers are forced to sell, no matter what the markets then may be, shortly after their crops are harvested. No manufacturing exists on this island except to supply a few local wants. Labor is abundant and cheap, such labor leaving this Province in large numbers for the United States and the western Provinces of Canada. All four months of the year, practically efforts to utilize this labor supply in local manufactures on a larger scale had to be given up, as the means of shipping manufactured goods from here are, during at least this Province."

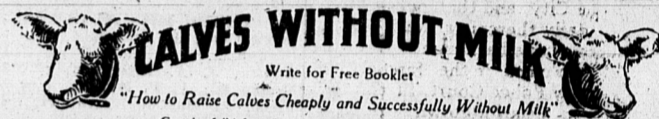
