THE PEOPLE'S DELEGATION.

As before announced today is the date fixed for the delegates appointed at the Provincial Convention to set out for Ottawa there to present to the Government our claims for immediate and permanent relief from our winter isolation.

This fact in no way affects the status of the obligations imposed upon the delegates appointed by the Provincial Convention. Having been appointed and having accepted the trust they must proceed to Ottawa and present their case under the resolutions as adopted at the Convention.

that the Government (and the Legislature also, we trust) recognise the gravity of the situation and will take action to demand our rights. Still other delegations on the like mission may be necessary before we secure all that we so urgently need and which the Government at Ottawa is solemnly obligated to provide—efficient steam communication summer and winter with the Mainland.

Already our claims have been strongly presented in Parliament by our representatives of both political parties. The delegation appointed at the Provincial Convention were also chosen without regard to party. The movement behind the Convention was wholly a popular movement. We must give the Government at Ottawa line upon line and precept upon precept in this matter.

The Dominion Atlantic Railway Company which is displaying great enterprise, is said to be seeking running powers over the Intercolonial with a view to establishing a thirty hours service over their lines between Sydney and Boston.
