The following extract from the editorial column of The Charlottetown Patriot, is timely and pertinent:

There should be no misunderstanding or obscurity about the questions involved. The alternatives are plain and unequivocal. The new Temperance Act deals with methods of purchase. To suggest that it authorizes the "opening of bar-rooms" is fantastic and devoid of truth, and is equally as absurd as the delusion that Prohibition completely prohibits....It is hoped that all qualified voters will vote, and that the result will be decisive....It is also hoped that following the excellent and prudent attitude of the Provincial Women's Institute, voters will face the facts without emotionalism, and that they will cast their ballots in accordance with their experience, and observation of the various phases of the problem.
