### GEN STOESSEL BEING TRIED BY COURT MARTIAL

Accused of Surrendering Fortress of Port Arthur Before He Had to

St. PETERSBURG, Dec. 11.—The final stage of the court martial of Lieutenant General Mikhailovitch Stoessel will begin in this city today. There have been protracted delays in taking the testimony of the witnesses in the Far East, but now all this material is in order and the proceedings will go on rapidly.

General Stoessel is accused of having surrendered the fortress of Port Arthur before he had exhausted all the resources of defense. The punishment of this, under the Russian code, is death. He is to be tried also on the charge of lacking initiative and with having exceeded his powers. General Fock and General Reiss are co-defendants with him. The first is accused of having conspired for the surrender of the fortress, and the second with having executed the order of surrender. General Smirnov, General Stoessel's most bitter enemy, is to be tried on a minor count.

### ALCOHOL IS AN ALARMING AID TO SUICIDE

The dangers Associated With it Overbalance Its Supposed Merits
