TORONTO, Jan. 19 —(CP)—Due to strength in the senior gold stocks the exchange's gold share index registered a minor net gain today while other indices were down moderately. Base metals posted the widest losses.

Outside buying was reported in the senior golds. A thousand share block of Lake Shore was sold and the aggregate turnover in the issue was 4.50 shares with the price holding unchanged at 52 3-8 at the close. Dome advanced 1 1-4 to 57 1-4. Hollinger 1-8 to 13 3-8 and McIntyre a point to 42 7-8. Wright-Hargreaves pushed up 20 cents to 7.70. O'Brien was caught in another selling storm and the price was hammered down to 3.10 from which level it recovered to 3.40 for a net loss of 25 cents. Hudson Bay and Noranda closed unchanged and smelters finished the minimum fraction down the Cheaper base metals were less firm. Falconbridge lost 35, Sudbury Basin 10, Ventures 25 and Aldermac and chromium 2 to 3 1-2. Minor losses predominated in the western oils.
