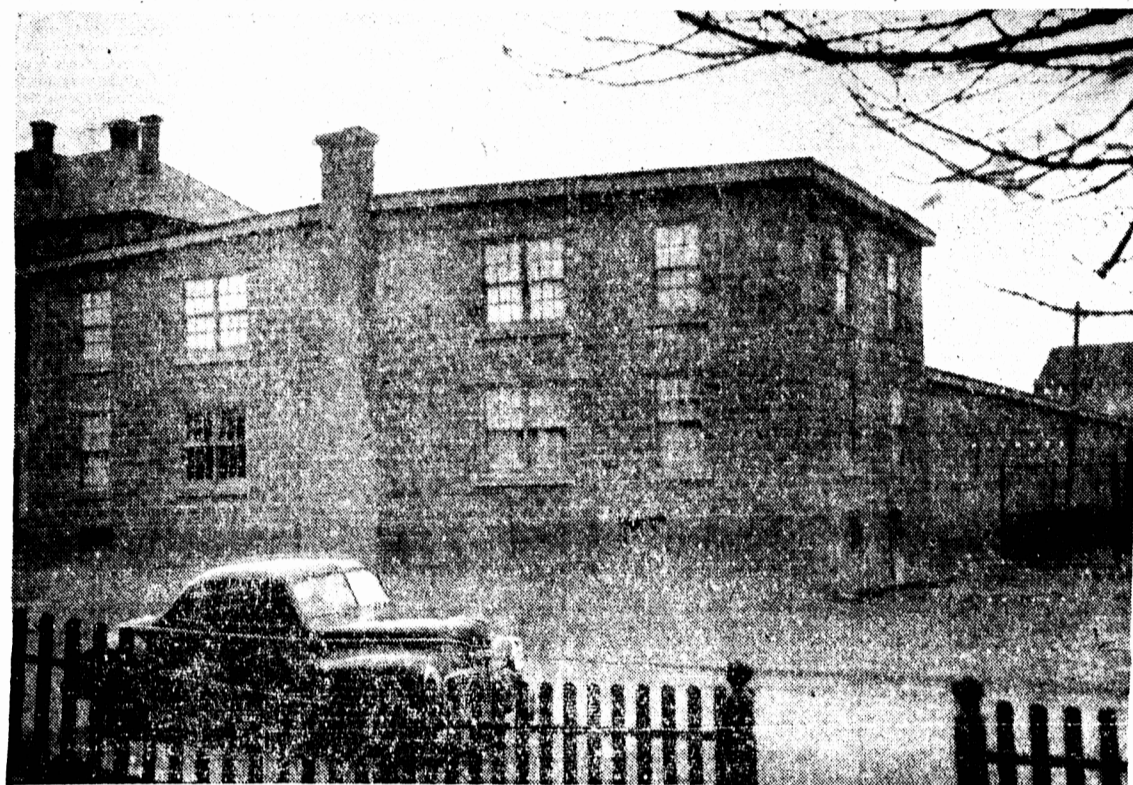

## Will Prove Decided Boon To Game In Western Town

Summerside's new Curling Rink pictured above which opened this week is a credit to the town and an important addition to the recreational and social facilities available in the community. Located on Notre Dame Street just to the rear of the Court House, the new rink is constructed of concrete blocks and has three ice surfaces. It is the first artificial ice rink in the town and approximately three and one half miles of piping have been laid.

The main floor club room has to be seen to be appreciated. Large plate-glass windows give an uninterrupted view of the three rinks and the members can watch the play from the comfort of regular recreation hall chesterfield suites. In the center of the back or north wall is a beautiful stone fireplace that had been in the officers' mess of the Mount Pleasant airport during the war. The entrance to the building is on the east side and one does not enter directly into the club room but into an entry hall. Off this hall and on the east side of the club room is the secretary's office. On the west side is the canteen. The main floor club room is finished in serrated plywood with a red maple finish which gives an unusual and pleasing effect.

Work on the second floor where there will be a room for holding small dances or dinners is being rushed to completion. There will be a ladies' powder room on this floor also. The finish on the second floor is of knotty pine. There is a kitchen on this floor.

In the basement is located the freezing unit and it is also planned to finish part of this section for any use that the club may wish to put it to. There are approximately 120 members in the club at present which is by far the largest membership in the club history. A ladies club has been organized and two afternoons a week have been set aside for them. In order to introduce curling at an early age two afternoons a week have been set aside when curling will be taught to school boys and they will be given an opportunity to learn and play the game. The formal opening of the new rink will be on February 9th —S.

The people of Summerside should be proud of this fine addition to the many facilities for enjoyment already available to them. The program of the Curling Club of teaching the game to young boys will bear fruit, we are sure, in better curlers for the future and better young men for their association with the older men of the town.
