A large number of relatives and friends of the bride and groom were present.

Mr. and Mrs. Kearney left by the express train this evening for Lunenburg.

The different companies of the 15th Regiment of Riflemen and the Field Battery are nearly all at drill now.

Not very much was done on Tuesday, but a muster parade took place Wednesday afternoon.

NEW YORK, June 26—The Federal wood, a small and apparently harmless little British steamer, lying on the outer edge of the shipping wharf, caught the front Brooklyn water-front, was held up by United States customs officers tonight on suspicion that the vessel was about to engage in a filibustering expedition against the West Indian republic of Santo Domingo.

FERRING SHEEP TICKS.

Sir—I read with interest in The Guardian your article about keeping lambs in good condition in the summer time, and when reading it have been wondering if the island farmers realize that it must cost from \$20,000 a year to feed sheep ticks. There must be 40,000 sheep and lambs on the island and I am sure it costs 50 cents apiece to feed the ticks on each sheep and lambs. That is the sheep would thrive that much better if kept clear of these pests.

The farmers could get a tick-destroyer wash or powder in the Charlottetown or Summerside stores and it is a matter of only a few hours to treat a whole flock. All sheep-rangers should see to their flocks by destroying the ticks so the lambs will stay and be in condition for the fall trade.

OTTAWA, June 26—Ability and merit are to hereafter take precedence of seniority in the promotion of officers in the various branches of the road's service. Instructions will be given to all heads and sub-heads to report regularly upon the capacity and natural special talents of every man immediately under them and those reports are to be made regularly. In this way the board management will be able to keep tabs on the talents of its employees, and will be in a position to select the best men to fill higher posts when vacancies occur.

Promotions hereafter will necessarily be confined to the rank in the various branches of the road's service. Instructions will be given to report any case where a man in one category of the service has special aptitude for the work in some other branch and the man will be placed accordingly. This system has been adopted with signal success on several of the best managed railroads in the United States.

The board of management is now having a complete classification made of all the employees of the system as a basis for putting this plan into operation.

OTTAWA, June 26—A Winnipeg deputation was received by Sir Wilfrid Laurier this afternoon and presented their request for a grant from the Dominion government of \$2,500,000 for the proposed world's fair at Winnipeg in 1920. The deputation advised that they must have a few hundred votes of all that this grant would be spread over three years and would be justified by its value in advertising Canada and promoting immigration. He expressed his sympathy and promised to confer with the finance minister and other members of the government. The deputation was presented by Hon. Clifford Sifton, who entertained them tonight at dinner.

MONTREAL, June 26—W. C. McIntyre, head of the big dry goods firm of McIntyre & Co., one of the leading business men of Montreal was almost instantly killed last evening in an auto accident ten miles above the City. With him at the time were Percy Cowan, a well known broker and W. S. Weldon, Manager of Windsor Hotel and a chauffeur. Cowan was injured internally. Weldon was severely shaken up, while the chauffeur escaped unharmed.

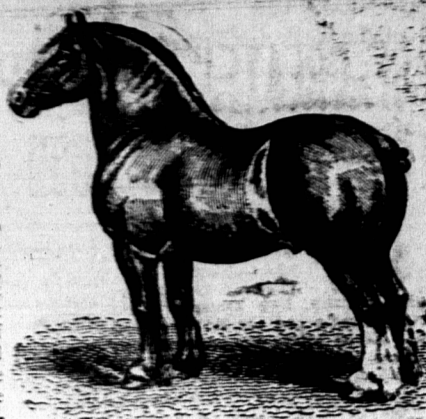

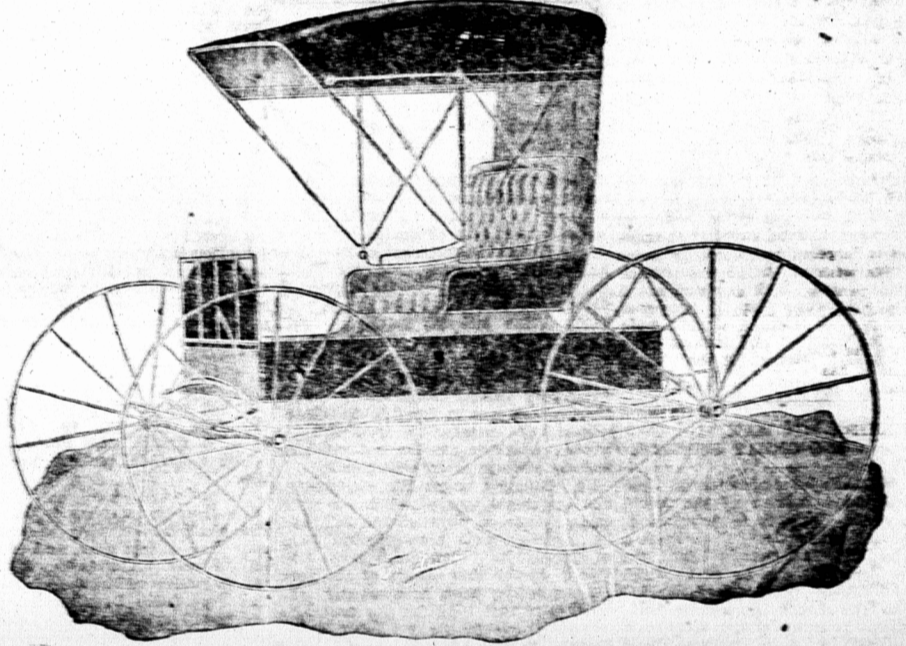
