## POPE ASSAILS COMMUNISM AND PAGANISM

### Encyclical Criticism of Pagan Trend Believed Directed at Germany.

(A.P. By Guardian's Special Wire) VATICAN CITY, Sept. 29.—Pope Pius today uttered equally stern criticism of Communism and its opponents who practice a "pagan" cult of state.

The prelates interpreted the latter as a reference to Germany.

The Papal rebuke, aimed apparently at Russia, Spain and Mexico as well as Germany, came in an Encyclical calling Roman Catholics to prayer for salvation of the world in the face of destructive atheism.

The Encyclical was published as Italian newspapers printed the full texts of Berlin speeches made by Premier Mussolini and Chancellor Hitler and as Rome officials announced a huge demonstration of homage for Mussolini when he returns tomorrow.

Relegated to the back page of Italian newspapers, the encyclical proclaimed that Communism "rears itself in denial even of all right to private property" as the world reached a spiritual crisis due to forgetfulness of God.

On the other hand the Pontiff insisted there are men practicing a cult of state whose anti-Communist measures lead the people of "exhume pagan errors and morals," a reference prelates interpreted as underscoring the Vatican's long conflict with German National Socialism.

The Pope branded all atheists as "enemies of the eternal."

"While they turn their scorn upon hope of celestial well-being they incite men to seek with illicit means terrestrial happiness," his encyclical declared, "and with fearless audaciousness propel them toward dissolution of order, thereby bringing about disorder, growing rebellion, and finally the conflagration of civil war."

His pointed words were seen as a rebuke to republican Spain whose civil war enemy, General Franco, has gained quasi-recognition from the Vatican.

As an antidote for these ills the Pope urged public and private recitation of the Catholic Rosary, promising that the Virgin Mary would be victorious over modern anti-Christian assaults as she "has been over all heretics."

No nation was mentioned by name except Poland whose people were exhorted to pray against the insults offered with impunity to the Blessed Virgin by the press of a civilized country.

Though the Berlin speeches of Hitler and Mussolini saw Communism as European civilization's greatest enemy, the Pope placed equal blame on anti-Communists whose "desire to restore order and public authority against intrigues of Communism lead men to forget the wisdom of the gospel."

The Vatican and Nazi Germany have long been at odds over the church's claim to the right of educating German Catholic youth and over trials of Catholic priests and laymen on immorality charges.

More church policies too have created conflict with the Vatican and have caused the Pontiff to class Mexico and Communist Russia as atheist-troubled sections of the world.

In the face of this crisis "even as at the time of the crusades," the Pope said, "all faithful, whether in cities or in country, should raise up their voices as one in confident supplication to Our Lady."

### Liberal Speaker Is Hooted Off Platform

(By The Canadian Press) WARKWORTH, Ont., Sept. 29.—William A. Fraser, Liberal M.P. for Northumberland, was shouted off the platform at a nomination meeting here today when he referred to Ross Sheppard of Toronto as a "political manure spreader."

Sheppard had preceded the member of parliament to the platform in support of Ray Willmott, nominated as Conservative candidate for Northumberland against Harold M. Carr, Liberal, in the Oct. 6 elections.

### Body Of Senator Will Lie In State

(By The Canadian Press) MONTREAL, Sept. 29.—Gowned in the robes of a Privy Councillor, the body of Senator Rodolphe Lemieux will lie in state in Montreal's huge Basilica to receive homage from a nation in whose parliament he sat more than two score years.

Body of the distinguished lawyer, lecturer and veteran parliamentarian who held the first of four portfolios in the Liberal Cabinet of the late Sir Wilfrid Laurier, will be taken to St. James Cathedral prior to the funeral Friday morning.

From the Cathedral, in downtown Montreal, the cortege will move to Cote de Neiges Cemetery to inter the body of the Senator who died at his Sherbrooke Street home yesterday after a lingering internal ailment.

### Would Boycott Japanese Goods

By Guardian's Special Wire) TORONTO, Sept. 29.—Sam Carr, Toronto Secretary of the Communist Party of Canada, said today the party at its convention which opens here Oct. 8, would call for a nation-wide boycott of Japanese goods. The program includes parades and demonstrations in front of Japanese consulates.

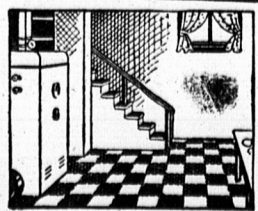
