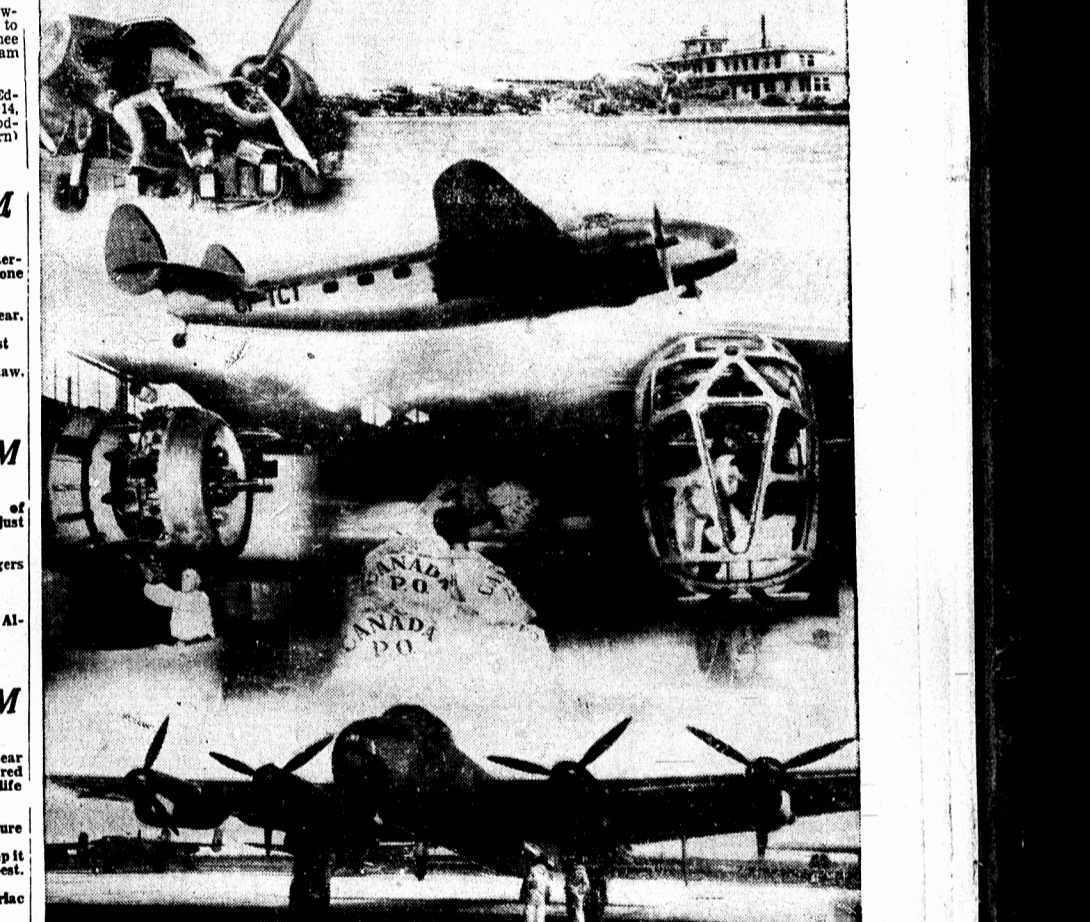

War Causes Big Increase in Air Traffic



War conditions have brought about a tremendous increase in air traffic mail letters in 1943, apart from the routes totalling 4,903 miles between the trans-Atlantic mail service which operates for the Canadian Government to expedite the delivery of mail to and from the armed forces in the European theatre of war. Operating revenues were \$9,379,501, an increase of \$2,042,183 over 1942. T.C.A., (exclusive of the trans-Atlantic operation), in 1943 provided service—air mail, passenger and express—overcarry this mail across the Atlantic.
