INDIA'S DISCONTENT GIVES GREAT ALARM

Bomb Outrages Recall Similar Ones Which Preceded the Great Mutiny.

NEW YORK, May 24.—There is much searching of heart respecting the future in India. It is not a frontier war when another sudden attack on the Lancers is reported, for the disturbances by the Mohmands will be suppressed by Sir James Willcock's three brigades and the influence of the Ameer's Anti-British brother effectively counteracted. It is the recurrence of bomb outrages among the native population that creates the alarm. Few dastardly political crimes have been committed since the opening of the year, and Englishmen cannot forget that similar outrages betokening the sullen discontent and native unrest preceded the great mutiny. There is an important distinction between the two series of lawless outbreaks. The outrages of half a century ago affected the native army which is now more loyal and better disciplined than ever before. It is the whole population that is now showing signs of restlessness, after being quiescent and apathetic for a long period. Superficial writers hold Keir Hardie responsible for

fermenting the discontent, but evidently exaggerated his resources as a mischief maker. A more philosophic deduction is that the unrest in India is a sign of the re-awakening of the East in consequence of Japan's campaign with Russia. When Indian villages were illuminated in honor of Japanese victory something was done to light up Oriental imagination and to forecast the possibilities of a recovery of an ancient prestige by the yellow and brown races. Fortunately Lord Kitchener is in India and Viscount Morley of Blackburn is in the House of Lords, where he can remain silent and not be subjected to cross examination by needless, thoughtless socialists.

THE SUPREME COURT OF CANADA

Can Municipalities Tax Income of Officials of the Dominion.

OTTAWA, May 24.—The arguments in Farrell vs. Manchester were concluded and judgment was reserved. Abbot vs. the city of St. John was taken up. The question raised on this appeal is whether or not the municipality of St. John had power under provincial legislation to assess the income of an official of the Dominion government. This question has heretofore been settled in Canada against municipalities, but the judicial committee of the privy council in a case from Australia decided in 1906 in the case of Webb vs. Ostrim (1907 A. C. 81), that the state of Victoria could tax the salary of an official of the commonwealth of Australia. The supreme court of New Brunswick followed that decision in the present case and held that the Dominion salary could be taxed. Judgment was reserved.

Powell, K. C., appeared for the appellant, Skinner, K. C., for the respondent. The court adjourned until Tuesday, May 26th, for the purpose of hearing appeals on the Ontario list.

FOUR FAILURES IS THE LIMIT

Acadia Rules a Student Must Make at Least Second-Class.

WOLFVILLE, May 24.—The Acadia faculty has adopted the following stringent regulations in respect to the work of undergraduate:—

"(1) When there has been failure in four examinations the year must be repeated, and all subjects must be taken over in class except those in which the student made first-class standing.

"(2) A student must make at least second-class standing on half of his studies each year; otherwise, he will be required to repeat the year, and all subjects in which he has not made first-class standing must be taken over in class.

"(3) No student who has failed in more than three term examinations of the preceding year or years will be promoted to a higher class."

At present the pass mark at Acadia is 45, which is considerably higher than that of other maritime colleges. These new regulations, while raising the standard, will be likely to lessen the number of students in attendance. Especially will this be true in the case of students preparing for the ministry.

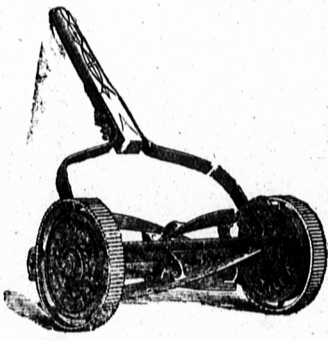
