# CASUALTIES MORE THAN SPANISH WAR

CHICAGO, July 7.—The Tribune today publishes its ninth annual summary of the death and injuries caused throughout the United States by yesterday's celebration of the Declaration of Independence. The figure up to an early hour today were as follows:

Dead, 38—By fireworks 9, by cannon 1, by firearms 11, by explosives 7, by toy pistols 4, by runaway 1, by drowning 5, injured, 2,789—By fireworks 1,099, by cannon 281, by firearms 303, by explosive 107, by toy pistols 304, by runaways 35, Fire loss \$86,550.

Last year 42 persons were killed outright, and when lockjaw and other diseases induced by injuries completed their work, over 400 lives had been sacrificed.

The number of injured, 2,789 is in excess of last year's figures by 358.
