Delegates from many States are in attendance. Robert W. Heberd secretary of the New York State Board of Charities, is the president of the association and the presiding officer of the convention. On Thursday the delegates will go to Jacksonville to inspect the State school for the blind, the State school for the deaf and Illinois' first State hospital for the insane.
