A despatch from Chatham, N. B., of recent date says that C. T. Munroe, of Ferryville, returned last week from Petticoat, where he was making preparations to start a fox ranch. It is understood that a company composed mostly of local men and with a capital of about \$40,000 will be organized with Mr. Munroe at its head and the ranch will be operated the first of September. The City of Sydney, which ran aground at South Bar Saturday morning while entering this port on her regular voyage from St. John's, got afloat again at 5.20 Saturday afternoon. The Douglas H. Thomas was beside the City of Sydney, waiting for high tide to endeavor to float the steamer. Her assistance was not necessary, however, as the City of Sydney moved off easily under her own power. She proceeded at once to the pier, where an examination of her bottom was begun by divers. The examination showed that the ship had not suffered the slightest damage. She immediately proceeded to take bunker and four cars of outward cargo, leaving yesterday morning at 6.30 for Montreal. The City of Sydney was scheduled to sail from Sydney at 10 o'clock Saturday morning, so that the slight accident puts her twenty hours behind her regular time. It is expected that she will be able to make this up however, and that she will be here on time returning from Montreal on Saturday next.—Sydney Exe. (The City of Sydney calls at Charlottetown.
