Selected steels, motors, farm implements, rubbers, rails and specialties were the principal climbers and advances of fractions to three or more points predominated in the final hour.

General Motors stock finished with a gain of 1-1/4 points at 50 1-8. Chrysler yielded 1-8 at the last at 101 7-8 after having been ahead the greater part of the day.
