Not only this, but better results in fit and adhesion are obtained in difficult cases, than in the use of rubber.

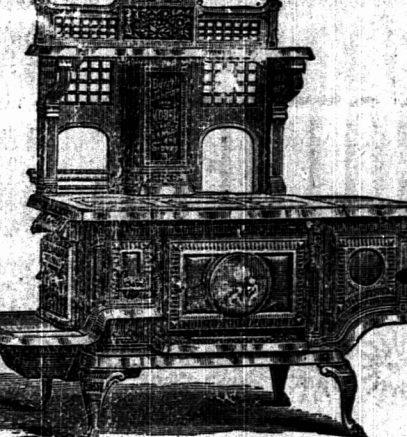
