Synopsis of Canadian Northwest Land Regulations

THE sole head of a family or any male over eighteen years old, may homestead a quarter section of available land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the District. Entry by proxy may be made at any Dominion Lands Agency but not Sub-Agency on certain conditions.

1. Title-Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within five miles of the homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres, on certain conditions. A habitable house is required except where residence is performed in the vicinity.

2. Titles-Six months residence in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section along side his homestead. Price \$3.00 per acre.

3. Titles-Six months residence in each of three years after earning homestead patent; also 50 acres extra cultivation. Free-emption patent may be obtained as soon as homestead patent, on certain conditions.

A settler who has exhausted his homestead right may take a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties-Must reside six months in each of three years cultivate 50 acres and erect a house worth \$300. The area of cultivation is subject to reduction in case of rough, scrubby or stony land. Live stock may be substituted for cultivation under certain conditions.

Italians Occupy Enemy Positions

(Special to the Guardian) ROME, Oct. 25.-Artillery action is again impeded by bad weather, says today's official announcement, but on the Julian front our batteries were very active against the enemy's commissary depots, at Duindo, Brestovizza and Comen. In Carso our troops in surprise attacks recaptured certain points on the front.

PETROGRAD, Oct. 24 via London.-The occupation of Constanza and Medjidie in Dobruja, by forces of the Central Powers, is announced in today's War Office report. Under hostile pressure, says the statement, the Russian and Rumanian troops retired to the heights, North of these places.

No notably important operations along the Rumanian North Eastern front are reported in the official announcement, which follows:-

Rumanian, Northwestern front: In the valley of the river Trotus the enemy remains passive. Along the Buzou-Dobrina-Knopoling line artillery duel is proceeding. Enemy attacks in the region of Orsova were repelled by our fire.
