**FIGHT AT A CONCERT**

Police Have to Clear Hall After Tumult Over Composition

Extraordinary scenes were witnessed at a concert given in one of the most fashionable halls in Vienna. The conductor was Herr Arnold Schoenberg, the peculiarities of whose compositions have aroused much opposition. Upon the orchestra striking up his "Chamber Symphony" tumult broke loose. As Herr Schoenberg was conducting a work of his pupil, Anton von Webern, the noise rendered it impossible to continue the performance, and those responsible for the demonstration were turned out of the hall.

The concert was then continued, but the scandalous scenes assumed a worse form. Those responsible for the arrangements jumped from the seats in the stalls and dealt blows at all who were concerned in the tumult. Finally the fighting became general, and the police were summoned, while the performers took up their instruments and left the hall.

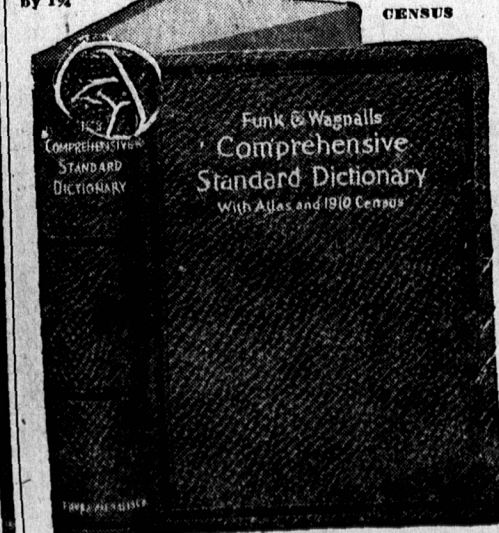
