PUBLIC HEALTH OF CHARLOTTETOWN

the most dangerous insects in the world?

Do you know that flies breed in manure, that they thrive in filth, and carry it on their feet and bodies into our homes and on to our food? If you would follow the progress of a swarm of flies from their breeding place, noting their fondness for roaming in dirty, unsanitary, open privies, then coming in through unscreened doors or windows, alighting and wiping their dirty feet on the dinner you have placed on the table, or perhaps going from that to revel in a cuspidor someone who may be sick is spitting into, then flying over to visit a baby in the cradle, walking over its mouth and leaving thousands of disease germs in their trail; and perhaps drowning in some milk that is being prepared for the baby, you would realize the greatness of this fly pestilence. Do you know that one pair of flies will raise a progeny of several generations in a season; so great a number of descendants in fact, that if all survived I do not believe any of us in this building has a home large enough to contain them, though they were put in under pressure. We have no means of verifying this statement, but I certainly believe it to be correct. (The Merchants' Association of New York estimates that the progeny of one pair of flies for one summer, if all survived, would occupy a space of 14,000,000 cubic feet, even if pressed together). This being so, is it not necessary to kill all flies on sight, which helps a little? But how much more is it necessary to stamp out the breeding places?

Do you know that not more than about one half of the homes in Charlottetown have a sewer connection; and that the remainder have the old and generally unsanitary privy or outhouse, where flies can get access at all times?

Do you know that many of our places of business are not properly fitted with sanitary conveniences for the employees?

Do you know that pigs and pig-sties are permitted in your city, with the accompanying filth, noise and malodour?

Do you know the remedy? Here it is:
(1) Insist that the Water Commissioners have their Act amended, so that the installing and using of the sewers be made compulsory by all people who have built homes since the passing of the Act, thus carrying out what was undoubtedly the intention at that time. Also ask that all homes of over a certain rental value must have sewer connection.

(2) Insist that all closets and privies where these are necessary) be properly built and screened, and kept sanitary, being emptied frequently.

(3) Insist on a weekly (at least) scavenger service all over the city, at any rate for the 6 months from May 1st to October 31.

(4) Insist that no pigs be allowed to be kept in Charlottetown during these same months, nor at any time unless properly licensed parties have them, under efficient inspection.

(5) Insist that butchers be not allowed to kill meat in unsanitary slaughter-houses, where pigs are kept, and where the offal is fed to these pigs, which are afterwards killed and sold to you.

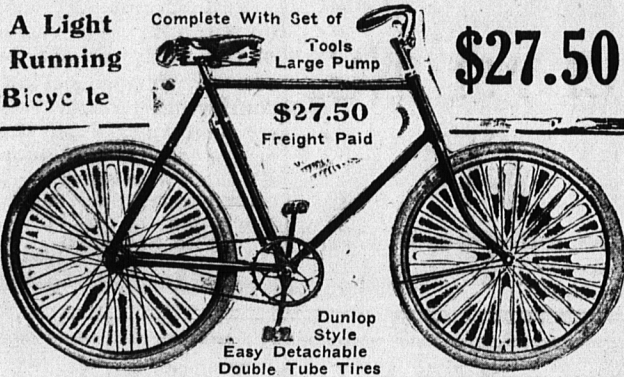
