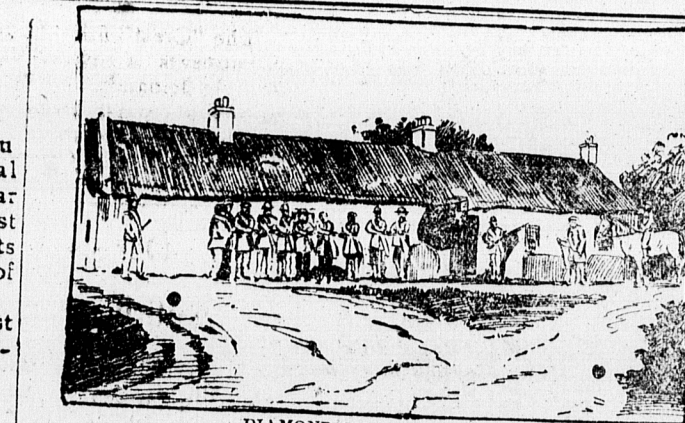

BOSTON, Feb. 8.—Thomas W. Lawson, who has attended the revival services at Tremont Temple says Dr. Chapman and Alexander are "rip-roaring bulls on the human uplift." Mr. Lawson has given out this statement: "It is great. The singing, Alexander and his associates, splendid—preaching, Dr. Chapman, grand. This wonderful man, aside from his good producing, heart-and-soul uplift qualities, is the most finished artist I have ever listened to. Up to witnessing his superb make-up on performances this morning, Edwin Booth had stood at the head of my personally known list, but Booth's 'alas poor Yorick' was not equal as a delicious mind brain and heart stirrer of Dr. Chapman's Dudas Iscariot. I have long been wondering to what quality he owes after listening to him for a few moments it was easy to understand. He makes 'em think and then with an exquisite refinement of self-obliteration he steers their thoughts into the green lanes and white-topped daisy fields. A stunner by the artistic magnificence of Dr. Chapman, and his voice. Just before the close he asks the audience to bow their heads and bow them low, and one instinctively feels a coming prayer, but instead it is for the announced purpose of allowing those in the audience who desire prayers for their salvation to signify it by raising their hand without fear of observation. I have but little doubt but that each one of Dr. Chapman's meetings produces more good than all the pro and con elite reformers in a year. 'The people instinctively feel when in the midst of the ordinary Faneuil Hall flub-dub, saying the community spirit that they are listening to a hot air safety valving. I cannot imagine the makeup of a man or woman who could attend one of Dr. Chapman's meetings without thinking not only a bit more of himself but a bit more of the other fellow than when he went in. 'Yes, Dr. Chapman and Alexander and their associates are to a man bulls, red-blooded, rip-roaring bulls, on the human uplift.'—Post.

FOR RUNNING RIGHTS OVER THE I. C. R.

OTTAWA, Feb. 9.—It develops that during 1901, the Canadian Pacific and the Government conducted negotiations regarding running rights over the Intercolonial. The Government submitted a proposition that the Canadian Pacific should employ all intercolonial men dismissed through shortening of service; that the Intercolonial should not suffer decreased revenue; that the Canadian Pacific pay two per cent on the value of property used; also cost of maintenance and the share in the gross receipts of local traffic. Shaughnessy disregarded this offer, but in July last resumed negotiations repeating the original proposition to pay \$135,000 annual rental, and pay one and three quarter per cent on the property used. Since then nothing has been done.

P. E. I. HOCKEYISTS WERE ENTERTAINED

SYDNEY, Feb. 8.—The members of the Victoria Hockey Club of Charlottetown and the friends who accompanied them on their provincial tour, were driven about the city while here and shown the principal points of interest by Mayor Richardson and Ald.
