GREAT MUSICAL EVENT.—Charlottetown is privileged to hear too few prominent singers not to be delighted by the announcement of the prospective appearance of a really great one: Jessie Mivan MacLachlan, the greatest Scotch singer, living, will be heard in the Opera House, on the evening of Oct. 2nd. F. G. Spencer, the St. John concert director was in town Saturday, and completed the preliminary arrangements for the event, which in many ways will be the most auspicious in our musical history. Mr. Spencer has engaged Miss MacLachlan for nineteen concerts in the provinces, in the fall, just after her arrival from Scotland which will be about Sept. 17th. Space will not permit of an extended reference to the great singer's career, but in future issues the matter will be properly dealt with. Miss MacLachlan will be accompanied by a pianist and one of the finest tenors in America, Mrs. Harry McCluskey of New York. Undoubtedly the capacity of the Opera House will be well tested by the number which will be anxious to hear these great singers on the above date.

ON Saturday morning the Steamer Jacques Cartier left the city with upwards of 200 excursionists for the tea at Crapud. The Cartier arrived at Victoria at 1.15 but owing to the wind being off shore and the falling tide the steamer went aground and the passengers were landed in teams. It was quite late in the day before the steamer got to the wharf and consequently the Captain was not ready to leave until nine in the evening. Just before the hour of departure Mrs. James Mullins and Miss Lilla Higgins and little three-year-old boy left the grounds, which were about a mile from the wharf and were hastening to the boat when a team happened to come along and the occupants offered to take the little one and place him on board the boat in charge of the Captain. When the carriage arrived at the wharf it was found that the steamer was leaving, and it was feared the mother would not be able to join her son. The latter, however, had hastened after the team and was on the wharf almost as soon and immediately went on board the boat, and before she had time to make much enquiry about her child, the steamer was away from the wharf. The Captain, of course, had not seen the child, and enquiry made from those on the pier brought back the answer that a child was there about the age of the one missing. It was then dark and it was impossible for the mother to identify her boy through in the distance. The Captain tried to get back to the wharf but the conditions were against him. A young man then took the child in his arms and went on board a schooner lying at the wharf and endeavored to slide down the side of the vessel into a boat. When he put his foot on the side of the boat it slipped from under him and he went into the water with the child in his arms. Both disappeared for an instant and when they re-appeared a line was thrown which the young man caught but the child was troublesome and it was evident that both would have been drowned in course of a few minutes. Another man with great presence of mind, caught a rope and slid down gripping the side of the schooner with his feet. In this position he seized one in each hand and kept both from drowning until Capt. Cairns, Strait and Capt. A. Lord, rescued them. They placed the little one on board the steamer where he quickly recovered from his thrilling experience. The tea was a great success, however, and over \$600 was realized. The band furnished excellent music. The steamer did not reach the city until 1.30 Sunday morning.
