The people and press of the United States are much more tolerant in regard to monarchical institutions than they were in a past generation.

THE RUSSIAN SITUATION.

As more complete reports of the proceedings in the Russian Parliament come to hand it becomes more apparent how wide and irreconcilable are the differences between the Emperor and the people's representatives.

There seems to be no hint of conciliation or concession on either side. The Duma is too wise to separate and appeal immediately to arms.

Of the sixteen members of the Ottawa Cabinet as it was in 1896 only seven now remain. These are, Sir Wilfrid Laurier, Sir Richard Cartwright, Sir Frederick Borden and Hon. Messrs Fielding, Scott, Fisher and Patterson.

Lists of Eminent Islanders are coming in, not rapidly as yet, but there are more to follow. The lists received cover a very wide range of names, 150 or more have already been mentioned.

Synopsis of Canadian North-West Homestead Regulations.

ANY even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, excepting 8 and 26, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section of 160 acres, more or less.

The homesteader is required to perform the conditions connected therewith under one of the following plans: (1) At least six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years.
