MILL CLOSED.—The directors of Eanfield's Ltd., Truro, in which business many in this province are interested, decided on Tuesday to close their big mill down from this date to March 9th. This was forced upon them by bad trade conditions, due to the mild winter and the bad times in the west. This means that about 400 people will be out of employment for a month, and \$15,000 of wage earnings withdrawn from circulation. A great many of the employees will be able to go to their homes to pass the time, while others will find it a real hardship, not being able to hand enough to stand a month's idleness conveniently, says a rural Exchange.

PRINCE EDWARD.—There was a large attendance at the Prince Edward Theatre on Monday night, when an exceedingly interesting program was presented and fully appreciated. The leading picture was a stirring Pathé drama, "The Depth of Late", in which the extent to which feminine hatred can be carried was demonstrated. The film, in two reels, was replete with thrilling sensations, and the photography throughout was brilliant. It was a picture well worth seeing, and those who have not witnessed it would do well to pay a visit to the Prince Edward. "The Girl in the Middy" was an attractive and pretty Edison comedy, and came a sensible and well-judged contrast to the previous film. The whole thing turns on a society girl's rejection of conventional clothing in favour of short skirts and a Middy blouse, and naturally complications are the result of her act. "Dream of the White", a Kalem film, was another excellent production and was well received. The unique and exceptionally interesting play, "Her face was her Fortune", a serial, was splendid. The songs were, as usual, of a bright and "catchy" kind and the singers were loudly applauded.

mines have opened up and shipped such a large tonnage in such a short time. The vein has been opened from the surface, to a depth of 350 feet. The workings now contain between 5,000 and 8,000 tons of shipping ore and 50,000 tons of milling grade.

ANOTHER NEW CHURCH.—Good progress is being made on the St. Andrew Mission, under the leadership of Mr. Harrison Willett, who took charge of the mission in November. Owing to the scarcity of men, the work there has been supplied since the conference of 1912 by the pastor of the St. Andrew mission, Rev. F. M. Cysdale, who has done faithful work in the face of many serious disadvantages, chief among them being the absence from his own work and the fact that previously the church had been supplied with its own pastor. But the untiring efforts of Mr. Cysdale have resulted at last in the erection of a handsome new church, which was dedicated on December 7th, to the worship of God and the service of humanity. Rev. Arthur Barber conducted the service, being assisted by the pastor and the superintendent of the mission, through whose faithful efforts the building was erected. The choir of St. Andrew's Methodist Church furnishes excellent music for the occasion and the service was thoroughly enjoyed by a congregation that filled the building. The church is a frame structure 24x46 feet, built on a concrete foundation, with a small cellar for a furnace. The interior is neatly finished, and is heated and lighted by gas. The building complete cost \$1,500, most of which has been paid in cash, while the balance, with the exception of \$250, is covered by subscriptions. The work reflects a great deal of credit upon all who helped make the project possible. The people are hopeful, the whole town is interested, and the prospects for the future are bright. Bro. Willett and his workers have the best wishes of all their friends. Mr. Willett is a son of Mr. and Mrs. George Willett, Victoria P. E. I. Before taking up this work he was one of the staff of the Bank of Nova Scotia, Amherst, N. S. -V.

CODD LEASE NOW IN GOLD.—The following from the Denver Financial Record will be of interest to the many shareholders in this Province. A new shoot of ore, carrying two-thirds of its value in gold, has been struck in the shaft of the Rochester Hill Mining Company (Codd Lease) at Rochester, Nevada. The ore is from three to four feet in width and samples one hundred dollars per ton. The strike was made at a depth of 150 feet below the surface and 225 feet below the cross-cut tunnel that first opened the vein. The Codd Lease has made a wonderful showing. From May 3rd up to December 31st, the company shipped ore of a gross value of \$175,761.51, on which freight and treatment charges were \$7.50 per ton. \$64.
