Dull Session On Montreal Stock Market

MONTREAL, March 1 —(CP)—Most stock market prices idled throughout today's session but a few advanced as much as one point while others retreated narrowly.

Buyers showed most interest on the construction section and steel of Canada preferred firmed a point to 70 1-2. The common stock and building products improved slightly while United Steel held even. In rails, National Steel Car and Canadian Car preferred gained 1-8 each. Dominion Steel and coal dropped 3-8 to 10 3-8 but C. P. R., and Canadian Car common held yesterday's closing levels.

St. Lawrence Corporation preferred provided the bright spot on the paper section, moving up 1-2 to 12 1-2. Price Brothers and Bathurst were inactive but closed steady. Light selling pressure was felt in the metal section and Nickel and steel 3-4 to 52 3-4 and Consolidated Smelters 1-4 to 56 1-4.

Traders showed little interest in utilities and Bell Telephone, Brazilian, Galena, Montreal Power, British Columbia Power showed a little activity advancing 1-4 to 36 1-4. Imperial Tobacco eased 1-4 on an otherwise steady miscellaneous total sales: 99,700 shares; industrials, 23,000; mines, 76,700; bonds \$6,200.

TORONTO, March 1 —(CP)—Mining shares turned a bit heavy in the final stage of today's Toronto exchange session but the industrials and the western oils held part of their afternoon gains, plus index gains of .23 and .38 respectively. Gold shares dropped .42 and the base metals .13. Volume was small at 366,000 shares.

Lamaque and Sigma advanced 35 to 40 cents. The close was up narrowly for Pickle Crow, Premier and Teck Hughes. Wright-Hartman, Long Lac, Macassa, MacLeod-Cockshutt, O'Brien and Pioneer. McIntyre hit a new high at 56.

Gillies Lake was sold in volume at a loss of 2 cents and Bonda dropped 7 cents to 14. Other penny issues showing heaviness included Canadian Malartic, Gunnar, Madson and Paymaster.

The base metal shares moved sluggishly and losses of 1-4 to 3-8 for International Nickel and Noranda were the main changes.

Home Oil climbed 17 cents to 2-70. Calgary-Edmonton, Davies and Dalhousie firmed a few cents.

Abitibi pfd declined to 10 1-4, off 2 points to its low point for a year or two. Abitibi common weakened to 175. The Steel of Canada stocks added a point each and the close was strong for Canadian Bank of Commerce, Canadian Locomotive, Canadian National Sewer Pipe A, Walkers common lost 3-4 and Brazilian and C. P. R. finished on top.

MONTREAL, March 1 —(CP)—Receipts on Montreal livestock markets today were 50 cattle, 225 calves, 465 hogs and 15 sheep and lambs, plus 10 cars reported.

Cattle and hogs were unchanged. Calves were 50 cents lower. Sales of calves were slow and lower. Common to just fair quality calves brought \$7.50 to \$8.50. Common thin light veals were down to \$6.50. Grassers \$3 to \$3.25.

Buck lambs made \$7 to \$7.50. Sheep \$4 to \$5.50.

The bulk of the hogs were delivered on former contracts at \$9.75 for bacon fed and watered and \$13.50 rail grade cold weight. Maritime live stock market report: Rail grade hogs were 20 cents lower at \$12.20 hot weight. Sows were steady at \$7.80 dressed weight an \$5.65 off trucks.

Choice steers sold for \$7 good steers \$6.25, medium \$5.75, fair \$5.25, medium \$5.75, fair-2 pds. \$5.25, common \$3 to \$3.50. Choice heifers were \$6.25, good \$5.75, medium \$5.25, fair \$4.75 and common \$3 to \$3.50. Top cows made \$5 good cows \$4.75, medium \$4 fair \$2.75, to \$3.50. Canners and cutters were \$1.75 to \$2.50 with common bulls at \$2.50 to \$3.25 and butchers bulls \$3.25 to \$4.25.
