Popcorn for Hallow'en Pop corn the same as usual, and while still hot spread generously with butter. For one quart of popcorn, mix well together one-half cup powdered sugar and one teaspoon cinnamon. Sprinkle this well over the hot, buttered popcorn, and serve at once. ... Black Cat Cookies 2 1-2 cups sifted cake flour 1 1-2 teaspoon baking powder 1-3 teaspoon cinnamon 1-2 teaspoon soda 1-2 cup butter or other shortening 1 cup sugar 2 eggs well beaten 3 squares unsweetened chocolate, melted 1 tablespoon cream Sift flour, measure, add cinnamon, baking powder, soda and mix together three times. Cream butter thoroughly, add sugar gradually, and cream together until light and fluffy. Add eggs, chocolate, and cream, and beat well. Add flour, a small amount at a time, beating each addition until smooth. Roll into sheet on slightly floured board. Outline with a sharp knife any picture you like of a cat, a cat's head, a bat or a witch. Then cut the dough into desired shapes. Place on ungreased baking sheet and bake in moderate oven (350 degrees F) for 9 minutes. Makes 2 1-2 dozen cookies about 3 inches in size.
