New Creamery For Crapaud

A new and completely modern co-operative creamery is in process of construction at Crapaud to serve the upwards of 400 patrons furnishing cream to the manufacturing plant in this enterprising centre.

A feature of the new building is the provision for adequate refrigeration facilities for the butter, the creamery makes, and individual refrigeration lockers for three hundred creamery patrons where they can store such foods as meats, fruits and vegetables for their home use.

The butter storage room will provide refrigeration capacity for 125,000 pounds of butter which is about 2,250 boxes.

The plant is on a high elevation and is excellently adapted to provide good drainage facilities. The building is of frame construction with insul brick siding.

When the Crapaud plant is completed it will be the third co-operatively owned and managed creamery in the Province to have installed modern refrigeration equipment.

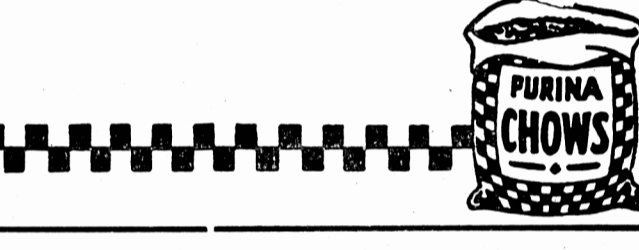
