EUROPAEN NEWS

PARIS, Nov. 4 (Special)—Baron Clement von Rodowicz, said to be a nephew of the former German Ambassador to Spain, and a relative, by marriage, of the Emperor William himself, was arrested here recently on a charge of swindling.

The baron, who is about 30, has squandered about six million francs within the last six years, and although his resources were exhausted he still kept up a country chateau with 18 servants, 15 horses, three automobiles and a town residence in the rue Pergolèse.

A little later the antiquary is said to have learned that his goods had been pledged or sold, and as the bills were not met on the appointed day he lodged a charge, and when the baron was recognized in a fashionable night resort he was hurried to the lock-up, although he argued that his difficulties were purely commercial and could only give ground for a civil law suit.

He had \$6,000 in bank notes upon him and Mlle. Yvonne d'Argent was wearing jewels worth more than \$20,000.

PARIS, Nov. 1 (Special)—Passing through one of his fields, a farmer of Troyes came upon the body, or what had been the body of a man lying in a mass some hundred yards from the highway. The corpse was unrecognizable. In one of the pockets of the overcoat was found a scrap of paper, on which were scribbled the words: "I am sacrificing myself for my children, they will pray for me. ST. PETERSBURG, Nov. 2 (Special)—The election returns impair any lingering hopes of an equitable distribution of parties in the Duma. The proportion of "Rights" approximates 60 per cent. Octobrist and Nationalist organs warn the Government that such a falsification of public sentiment is calculated to revive the unrest of 1905, and possibly bring on another revolution.

BERLIN, Nov. 2 (Special)—The new Zeppelin airship constructed for the Navy, which is designated "L 1," travelled over a thousand miles during its recent uninterrupted flight of thirty hours. Details as to the speed it is capable of attaining are withheld, but it is believed to be the fastest airship in existence.

The "Tagliche Rundschau" points out that if Hamburg had been the starting-place of Friedrichshafen "L 1," could have crossed the North Sea, made observations over Dover and Portsmouth, and returned to Hamburg via London, and seeing that it would still have had plenty of benzine on board it could have made further excursions, extending several hours, over the "most interesting places." The National organ adds that when five members of the Commission, who were on board to make sure that the airship fulfilled the requirements of the naval authorities, are replaced by more benzine and more war implements, the usefulness of "L 1" will be apparent.
