IRELAND TO HAVE BIG FAIR

London November, 7.—Next May we see the opening of the great Irish international exhibition. The guarantees fund now amounts to \$1,000,000. Lord Iveagh heading the list with \$50,000.

The building will resemble in scheme those of the late Paris exposition. A prominent feature will be a great dome the elevation of which will be equal to half that of St. Paul's Cathedral, London. If King Edward does not open the exhibition he will at least honor it with his presence at a later date.
