The coal company in Cape Breton is depending on increased sale of their coal in the provinces of Quebec and Ontario. Mr. Speaker, I wish to call the attention of this House to the immediate necessity of the coal company erecting coal plants at Montreal, Toronto, Windsor, Fort William and other centres for the storage of coal, the installing of coke ovens, and, if necessary, the manufacture of by-products from the coal.

At the time when Prince Edward Island entered confederation in 1873, we borrowed from the Dominion Government \$3,400,000 to pay for the railway which we had built. Adding interest at five per cent. to this amount brings the total cost of this railway to date to \$5,610,000. I do not think that any other province has had to pay for its railway accommodation in this manner.
