OPERA TONIGHT "IL TROVATORE"

The Boston Opera Singers have arrived in the city and will open at the Opera House to-night in Verdi's "Il Trovatore." The company have made a tremendous success in this piece as will be seen from the following notice taken from a Moncton paper.

The opera, which is universally admitted to be Verdi's chef d'oeuvre, gives great opportunities for dramatic fire and impassioned singing in the part of Azucena, the contralto role, and Miss Stitzler in this character was heard to great advantage in all her scenes. Following the well known anvil chorus in the second act, Azucena tells in an aria of intense energy the story of the burning of her mother. In this scene Miss Stitzler displayed a dramatic force which took the audience by storm and at the close the curtain was raised again and again for her to bow her acknowledgments. Her dramatic lament for Manrico when appearing manacled before the count, in the fourth act, ending with her being dragged away by the soldiers, was also particularly noteworthy.

The familiar duet in the prison scene, between Azucena and Manrico was given with great artistic effect.

Miss Helen Darling, the Loneria of the opera, had fewer opportunities but made an excellent impression. Her aria in the last act, followed by the lovely melody of the Miserere and the subsequent haunting refrain, "Better a thousand deaths to die than without thee to live," were among her best numbers.

Roland Paul as Manrico sang very effectively. He possesses a tenor voice of considerable range and pleasing quality in its upper register. The Count of Signor Alberti was a highly artistic interpretation. His fine baritone voice and command of appropriate gesture combined to make the noteworthy success of the performance.

F. J. Boyle as Fernando had few opportunities as the leading basso of the company.

The chorus of gypsies, nuns and soldiers was well balanced and the voices of excellent quality. The opera was lavishly costumed and well staged. The orchestra under the direction of Roberto E. Francini appeared to find no obstacles in the score and played the difficult music with much expression and with due regard for light and shade. The entire performance was in every way in keeping with the requirements of such an exacting undertaking and augured well for the three days of grand opera which should prove a source of delight to the musical public of Moncton. WINNIPEG BECOMING CITY OF BOULEVARDS

WINNIPEG, Man., Oct. 24. — In addition to paving her streets Winnipeg now has more than one hundred miles of parking between curbs and sidewalks, an average width of fifteen feet, and all the parking set with trees. The streets thus parked are called boulevards.

Winnipeg has found that it costs only about twenty-five cents a front foot to plant the parking strips and about three cents a front foot to maintain them, a ridiculously low figure compared with the great benefit received from the improvement. The tree planting costs about four cents a front foot.

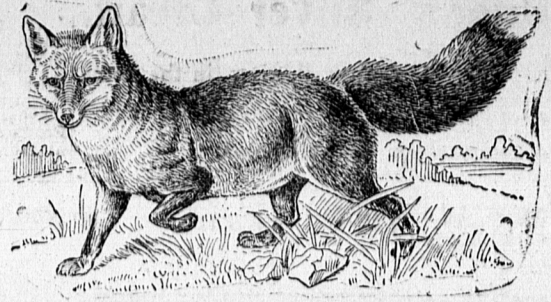

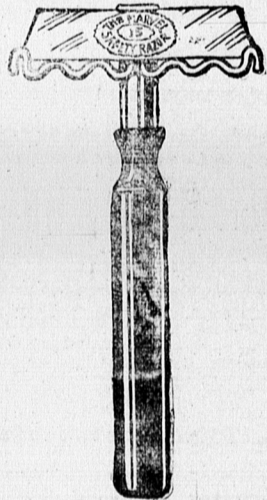
