



THE AUDITOR GENERAL.

To the Mackenzie Government is due the credit for having placed the Auditor General of Canada in an independent position from which he could not be removed except on a joint vote of the two Houses of Parliament. Mr. McDougall, who has since held that position was appointed shortly after the Audit Act was passed. He had before been a Liberal member of Parliament. In the execution of his office, he has had a varied experience, and has seemingly had more trouble with ministers of his own party than with Conservative ministers. Last year he applied for superannuation which was not granted. Since then his resignation has been talked of but only the other day Hon Mr. Fielding told the Public Accounts Committee that he would continue in office. Since then Mr. McDougall has resigned.

What new trouble has arisen since Mr. Fielding's announcement does not appear. Mr. McDougall has been an honest and capable official but lacked something of the required amount of suavity to temper his stern sense of duty. His differences with the present Government led to his being overlooked when a few years ago a number of the Deputy Ministers with whom he ranked as equal were given an increase of \$1000 each. Repeatedly his decisions have been overruled or reversed by the Treasury Board. He has had voluminous correspondence and much trouble in keeping some of his old friends straight, but nevertheless has yearly saved to the country many times the amount of his salary by preventing improper contracts from going into effect or improper payments being made.

In tendering his resignation Mr. McDougall asks that he be given a superannuation allowance in excess of that to which he is strictly entitled by his years of service. It is in the power of the Government to grant this but whether it will be done remains to be seen. Ministers are not usually very generously disposed toward anyone who has thwarted or attempted to thwart their purposes. Still we trust that the retiring Auditor will be granted most favored treatment for the undoubted service which it is on all hands admitted he has rendered to the country. His claim as presented is not in all respects admissible. That he has saved the country some money, even a large amount, was only in the line of his duty. But the general verdict of the country if it could be heard would give him full superannuation allowance. A successor equally capable, honest and insistent may not be very readily found.

Collector Bump of Charlotte, the port of Rochester, New York, who compelled a Canadian captain to lower the British flag on July 4 on penalty of being refused his clearance papers, is a type of American official of which the more enlightened of his countrymen will hardly feel proud. In Canada we are glad to have the citizens of any foreign country exhibit their flags at any time they choose. We have no fear of such displays and no feeling of envy. Some day we hope our neighbors will expand their minds to the Canadian breadth in these matters. In the meantime we shall make liberal allowance. Canada is in more than one respect bigger than the United States.

## INTERNATIONAL SUPREME LODGE.

The delegates from Canada to the big convention of the International Supreme Lodge, of the Independent Order of Good Templars, which takes place in Belfast, Ireland, next month, leave from Rimouski next week or the week after. The Nova Scotia delegates appointed were W. A. MacDonald, of this City, and J. A. Simpson, of Amherst. It is not certain that Mr. Simpson will, but Mr. MacDonald leaves here Monday, and before going to Belfast, he will visit London, Edinburgh, Banffshire and Inverarou, where his father was born. It is expected the attendance at the convention will be about 1,500 delegates from all parts of the world, and the convention opens on Aug. 1st, and closes on the 6th. The United States delegates will likely charter a steamer to take them across, and Colonel B. F. Parker, the Right Worthy Grand Secretary, whose headquarters are at Milwaukee, Wis., will have a big party to go. New Brunswick and P. E. Island will each send a delegate. Messrs. McDougall and Simpson will represent the Grand Lodge of Nova Scotia, in which there are 81 subordinate lodges, the two in Halifax being Minniehaha and Morning Glory. The delegates were appointed last year, and at the session of the Grand Lodge of Nova Scotia held at Stellarton this week, they received their instructions as to how to vote on questions to be submitted to the International Supreme Lodge, which is the title of the body which is to meet at Belfast.

These big meetings are triennial, and in the past have been held at Edinburgh, Christiania, Norway; Berne, Switzerland; Boston, Mass.; and other places. Mrs. Dickie, of this City, was a delegate to the session at Edinburgh in 1891, and up to this year, she was the only representative Nova Scotia had ever had at the session. —Halifax Chronicle.

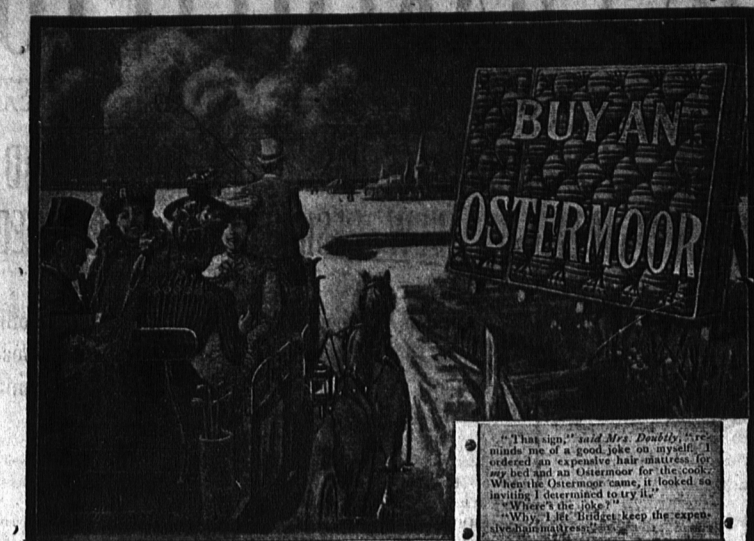
