MYSTERY OF SPHINX SOLVED BY REISNER

BOSTON, March 17 (Special)—More discoveries confirming the fact that the great statue of the Sphinx, on the Egyptian desert beside the pyramids, was fashioned to represent the head of the great Pharaoh Chephren, the grandson of that Cheops, who built the first pyramid, are contained in dispatches relating the latest successes of Professor George A. Reisner of Harvard University.

Within a few days at the most, Harvard authorities expect to receive fuller reports from Professor Reisner, whose latest explorations have confirmed his earlier ones, and disordered a temple 120 feet long in the lion-like body of the Sphinx.

Professor Reisner succeeded in removing the accumulated sands of the centuries from the interior of the head, and gained an entrance into the very body of the Sphinx.

The tomb is supposed to contain the mummified body of Menes I. Sloping passages lead from the temple to other chambers yet unexplored.

BURLESON GIVES A LAW ENFORCEMENT NOTICE TO PAPERS

WASHINGTON, March 12.—Unless the supreme court restrains Postmaster-general Burleson from enforcing the newspaper publicity law, as it was asked to do yesterday, he will immediately do so, regardless of an agreement by former Postmaster-general Hitchcock to withhold action pending a determination of its constitutionality.

Final notices have been sent to a number of publishers that if they do not furnish the information required by law within ten days their publications will be denied admission to the mails.

Approximately 91 per cent of the publications affected have filed their reports with the postmaster-general, and otherwise have complied with the law.

It was pointed out to-day, however, that Postmaster-general Hitchcock before leaving office, had on February 28 decided to terminate the agreement and had ordered postmasters to call upon publishers to submit their reports.

PEARY SAILS TO GET ROMAN MEDAL.

PORTLAND, Me., March 12.—Rear Admiral Peary will sail Saturday from New York for Rome, where he will be presented with a medal by the Royal Italian Geographical Society of Rome in honor of the discovery of the North Pole.

RUBE RELENTS.

SAN FRANCISCO, Cal., March 13.—"Rube" Marquard the New York National League pitcher who won two of the three games taken from Boston in the world's series of 1912 yesterday signed a contract pledging his yearly return to the team, now in training quarters at Marlin, Texas.

ON VOTES BY WOMEN.

BOSTON, March 13—"Votes for women" won its first victory in the Massachusetts legislature today.

The house, which annually since 1899 has rejected woman suffrage, today by a vote of 127 to 70 substituted for an adverse committee report, a resolution providing for a constitutional amendment which would strike the word "male" from the provision defining the qualifications of a voter.

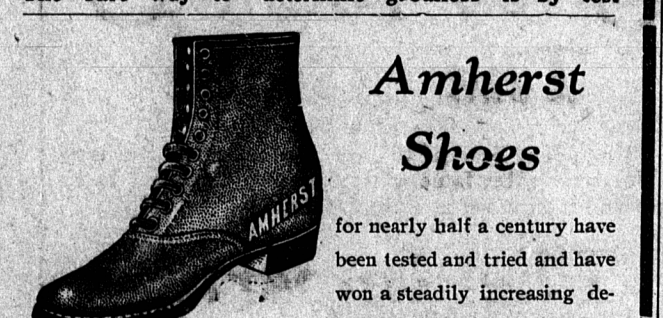
