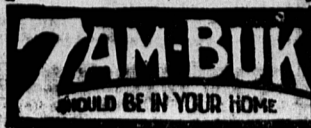

est sympathy I write you of the death of your son, Pte. D. J. MacLeod, in action on Sept. 28, 1918. It was while attacking an enemy strong point that he was hit by enemy machine gun bullets in the body and death followed immediately.

I have only known Pte. MacLeod for a short time, but during that period he acquitted himself as a man and a soldier and although we mourn his loss, still we know he gave his life for the greatest cause, that of 'Freedom and Justice.'

Your son was given a soldier's burial beside several of his comrades near Bourliou Wood and a cross marks his grave. If there is any further information I can give or anything I can do for you, please let me know.
