SUNDAY, OCTOBER 16th, 1949. LESSON THREE (Senior) ALCOHOL AND BEHAVIOUR

In the last lesson, we pointed out briefly the effect of alcohol upon the "clever forebrain". You will remember that this is the part of the brain that enables us to behave like human beings.

We have seen how alcohol impairs the power of judgment. It is only natural to suspect that this would also involve the power of self-judgment, or self-criticism.

At least one quarter of the inmates had been heavy drinkers. There may be some who feel that all this talk of crude and criminal behaviour has no application to them.

Such cases bring to mind another and related matter, the connection between alcohol and crime. Use of alcohol is often held responsible for crime. Just what are the facts?

Premeditated crime, (crime which is planned in advance) cannot usually be traced to liquor consumption. There are cases in which drink is used to build up the courage to carry out criminal intentions, but more often professional criminals make it a point not to drink before commencing a "job".

However, evidence seems to point to the fact that much impulsive, spur-of-the-moment crime is often committed under the influence of alcohol.

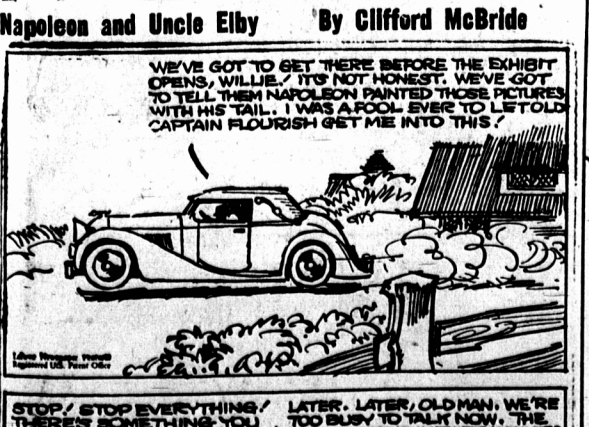
