Buying seeds and buying a horse there is a similarity in the transaction. The pedler must be looked into, it is important to know who raised the horse and blemishes and kindred troubles must not be overlooked. A poor horse is dear at any price, and this is doubly true of seeds, even if the seeds were to be had for nothing. Poor cheap seeds are very expensive to the grower, and there are seeds on the market, we could not be paid to plant.
