GERMAN NEWS BUDGET

BERLIN, Aug. 1.—The gigantic operation of draining and sewage of the city of Berlin is about to be completed after 38 years of labor and the expenditure of \$22,500,000. When the work was begun in 1873 the capital had only 860,000 inhabitants; now it has 2,163,000, excluding the suburbs.

The total length of the canalization pipes, which are of iron and earthenware, is just over 795 miles. This includes the rainwater tubes, which run into the Lower Spree, and the sewage conduits, which extend to the municipal sewage farms around Berlin. The beneficial effect of the modernization of Berlin's system of drainage is shown by the diminution of the cases of typhus fever from 1.40 per 1,000 in 1872 to 0.04 per 1,000 in 1909.

The establishment of night sanatoriums in the forests surrounding Berlin, where weekly factory workers and store clerks may congregate in the midst of pure air any evil effects of close confinement during the day, is the latest novel effort of the city sanitary authorities.

Three of these "night-cure" establishments, to which the sickly workers go direct from their workshops at 7 o'clock each evening, have been erected, two for women at Elehamp and Schonholz, and one for men at Johannisthal. On their arrival the workers are served with a hot supper and then retire to rest in hammocks in which they lie enveloped in sleeping sacks. They are sheltered by a roof from rain, but the sides are open and no curtains are permitted to hinder the free circulation of the air. At 5.30 o'clock in the morning breakfast is served and the patients proceed again to their work. All of those treated in this way have benefited to such an extent in health that the authorities have decided to build a large number of the sanatoriums so as to serve every district of the capital.

That Germany is still much behind France in aviation is the conclusion generally drawn from the results of the German Aviation Circuit race. Although prizes aggregating more than \$100,000 were offered, only fourteen of the 24 flyers entered took part in the contest and none were able to complete the entire circuit of 1,164 miles. The winner, Benno Koenig, dropped out of two of the thirteen stages of the flight.

Only three of the aviators crossed the finish line at Johannisthal. Lindpainter, who for three-quarters of the race looked like a certain winner, had to give up at last, his nerves completely shattered by the strain of thirty days of flying, and nerve, rather than machine defects or accidents, were responsible for the failure of most of the other competitors.

The contest differed from recent French contests in its freedom from serious mishaps, there being no fatalities nor serious accidents, except for the failure of most of the other competitors.

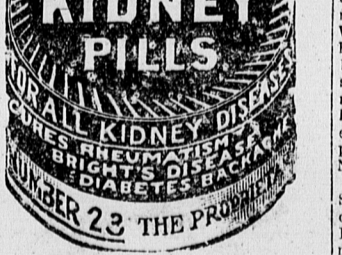

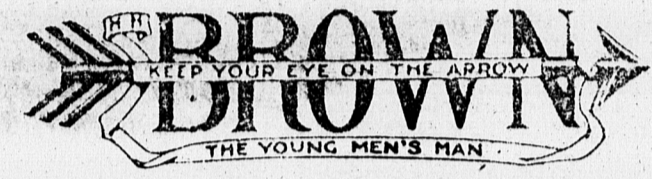

THE CHINA FAMINE.

NEW YORK, August 1 — A cable from Shanghai, China, received yesterday by the Christian Era, indicates that the relief expected in the famine stricken districts of China from the spring crops had been minimized by another flood.

"All Yantze valley flooded; awful destruction and death; terrible famine this autumn," the cable read.

CUBA THREATENED WITH REVOLUTION.

HAVANA, Aug. 3.—An uprising against the Government, of a serious character, occurred at Regla, a suburb of Havana, when General Acevedo, revolutionary veteran, with eight or ten companions took lead. It is reported that the party was reinforced later by two hundred men. Acevedo issued a manifesto denouncing the administration of President Gomez and adjuring all patriotic Cubans to rise and overthrow it. A strong detachment of rural and regular troops were despatched in pursuit of the rebels. There are rumors that a fight has already taken place.

THE REVOLUTIONISTS HAVE TRIUMPHED

PORT AU PRINCE, Aug. 3.—The cause of revolution in Hayti has triumphed. President Antoine Simon fled from the capital today and took refuge on board the Haytien cruiser, 17 December, with his wife and a number of his followers.
