Colored handkerchiefs are enjoying a vogue, and the most popular shades are numerous yellows and tans, including banana, lemon, and burnt orange. Sometimes the whole handkerchief is colored, with the merest line of white at the edge in the shape of a rolled hem. In other instances this is reversed, the handkerchief being white bound, with a color. Then, again, widely striped borders are used; in some cases a single stripe is 2 1/4 inches wide, leaving quite a small square of white in the centre, the rolled hem being also white. Very dainty are the little handkerchiefs with a veining edge in a pale color and a tiny initial or monogram to match.

Cross-stitch is introduced in some of the newest handkerchiefs, a smart effect being given by a single row of black cross-stitch on buff or burnt-orange linen a little way from the hem, while sometimes the rolled hem has a line of cross-stitch in a color on it. Even in plain white handkerchiefs there is always an effort to introduce novelty in the embroideries and hems that are used. Rolled hems put on by hand are popular, and another attractive border is a row of veining button-holed at the outer edge.

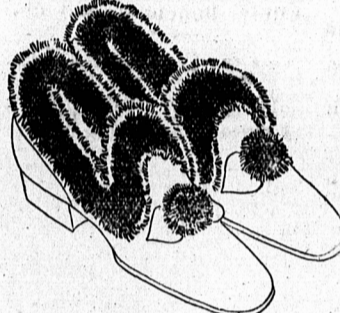
