NEW YORK FINANCIAL BUREAU

The Government crop report confirms favorable expectations. These two features are looming up more prominently in the minds of the investors and speculators who go beneath the surface, and there is a tendency to ignore Washington, so far as investment is concerned.

Idle car supplies will be heavily reduced during the next thirty days according to railroad officials who have carefully analyzed the fine government grain report.

American Smelting offerings are very limited. Gossip found in several offices says the short interest is of large extent. It would probably be forced to cover with much higher prices on receipt of better news from Mexico.

Atchison and Southern Pacific are favorable purchasers for speculative investment account. Sentiment in regard to them is very favorable throughout the street. Long accounts in both issues have been materially added to during the past two weeks.

Speculative accumulation of the copper shares is reported from well-informed sources in New England.

There has not been very much doing to-day. Missouri Pacific issues have all been weak and it looks like a receivership, exactly why or how, we are unable to discover as with Messrs. Gould, Speyer and Bush away, any radical action at this time would seem unlikely. Nevertheless there is an old saying that "the ticker talks louder than words", and it certainly indicates a bad state of affairs in this case.

The general market has acted well in spite of the weakness in Missouri Pacific and shows an inclination to advance. We think it certainly would do so on any reasonable excuse.

The crop statement yesterday was the best since 1904 which furnishes the basis for much encouragement. There is no news in regard to the rate decision and this is what we are waiting for at the moment.
